

#### COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, JUNE 1, 1940.

ALL MEAT. Storage stocks of all Canadian meat as reported on June 1, 1940 were 94,218,673 lb. In addition there were 440,000 lb. estimated for firms failing to report on time, making a total of 94,658,673 lb. This total shows an increase of 40.5 million lb, as compared with the total on hand a year ago. During May 1940 there was a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 2.4 million lb.

In addition to the above, 3,563,848 lb. Imported meat were reported in storage, making a Grand Total of all meat, Canadian and Imported, of 98,222,521 lb.

PORK. Holdings of Canadian pork as reported amounted to 70,174,149 lb. This total is divided into three classifications as follows: Fresh 5,000,508 lb.; Frozen 43,591,966 lb., and Cured and In Cure 21,581,675 lb. An estimate of 100,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time brought the Grand Total to 70,274,149 lb. In comparison with the stocks reported on May 1, 1940, an increase was noted, representing a net "Into-Storage" movement of 1.6 million lb. Last year there was an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 0.5 million lb.

In addition to the Canadian pork there were holdings of 3,289,914 lb. Imported pork reported.

LARD. The reported holdings of lard amounted to 4,612,708 lb. During May there was a net "Into-Storage" movement of 732 thousand lb. while last year there was a similar movement of 776 thousand lb.

Storage holdings of Canadian beef were reported as 18,605,947 lb. of which 5,510,292 lb. were Fresh; 10,208,449 lb. were Frozen; 849,759 lb. were Cured and In Cure and 2,037,447 lb. were Fancy Meats. An estimate of 300,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time brought the Grand Total to 18,905,947 lb. There was a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 4.0 million lb. during May 1940 while for the same period a year ago there was an "Into-Storage" movement of 0.8 million lb. The Total stocks this month are 17.6 per cent less than last month.

Additional holdings to the above were 98,317 lb. Imported beef.

VEAL.

Veal storage showed reports totalling 3,660,052 lb. of which 1,033,716 lb. were Fresh; 2,398,256 lb. were Frozen; and 228,030 lb. were Fancy

Meats. Adding an estimate of 25,000 lb. for late reports brought the total to 3,685,052 lb. A net "Into-Storage" movement of 1.2 million lb. for the month was noted while last year for the same period there was a similar movement of 0.9 million lb.

The Total stocks this month are 47.6 per cent greater than last month.

MUTTON AND LAMB. Storage of Canadian mutton and lamb showed a reported total of 1,778,525 lb. of which 112,311 lb. were Fresh; 1,574,432 lb. were Frozen, and 91,782 lb. were Fancy Meats. An estimate of 15,000 lb. increased the total to 1,793,525 lb. A net "Out-of-Storage" movement during May 1940 amounted to 1.1 million lb. while last year a similar movement amounted to 0.8 million lb. The Total stocks this month are 38.7 per cent less than last month.

In addition there were 175,617 lb. Imported mutton and lamb reported.
