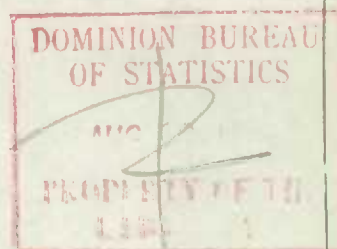

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, August 1, 1940

ALL MEAT. Storage stocks of all Canadian meat as reported on August 1, 1940 were 72,410,650 lb. In addition there were 205,000 lb. estimated for firms failing to report on time, making a total of 72,615,650 lb. This total shows an increase of 23.9 million lb. as compared with the total on hand a year ago. During July, 1940 there was a net "Out of Storage" movement of 13.5 million lb.

In addition to the above, 1,598,604 lb. Imported meat were reported in Storage, making a Grand Total of all meat, Canadian and imported of 74,214,254 lb.

PORK. Holdings of Canadian pork as reported amounted to 53,535,666 lb. This total is divided into three classifications as follows: Fresh 4,775,889 lb., Frozen 25,767,009 lb., and Cured and In Cure 22,992,768 lb. An estimate of 120,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time brought the Grand Total to 53,655,666 lb. In comparison with the stocks reported on July 1, 1940, a decrease was noted representing a net "Out of Storage" movement of 12.1 million lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 2.0 million lb.

In addition to the Canadian pork there were holdings of 1,458,963 lb. Imported pork reported.

LARD. The reported holdings of lard amounted to 4,538,775 lb. During July there was an apparent net "Out of Storage" movement of 147 thousand lb. while last year there was an "Into Storage" movement of 184 thousand lb.

BEEF. Storage holdings of Canadian beef were reported as 13,909,183 lb. of which 6,290,789 lb. were Fresh; 5,591,266 lb. were Frozen, 595,449 lb. were Cured and In Cure, and 1,431,679 lb. were Fancy Meats. An estimate of 65,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time brought the Grand Total to 13,994,183 lb. There was a net "Out of Storage" movement of 1.7 million lb. during July 1940 while for the same period a year ago there was an "Into Storage" movement of 201 thousand lb. The Total stocks this month are 10.7 per cent. less than last month.

VEAL. Veal storage showed reports totalling 4,265,889 lb. of which 912,941 lb. were Fresh; 3,018,645 lb. were Frozen; and 334,303 lb. were Fancy Meats. An apparent net "Into Storage" movement of 317 thousand lb. for the month was noted while last year for the same period there was an "Into Storage" movement of 75 thousand lb. The Total stocks this month are 3.0 per cent. more than last month.

MUTTON AND LAMB. Storage of Canadian mutton and lamb showed a reported total of 904,913 lb. of which 381,694 lb. were Fresh; 418,634 lb. were Frozen and 104,585 lb. were Fancy Meats. A net "Out of Storage" movement during July 1940 amounted to 166 thousand lb. while last year a similar movement amounted to 9,000 lb. The Total stocks this month are 15.5 per cent. less than last month.

In addition there were 139,641 lb. Imported mutton and lamb reported.

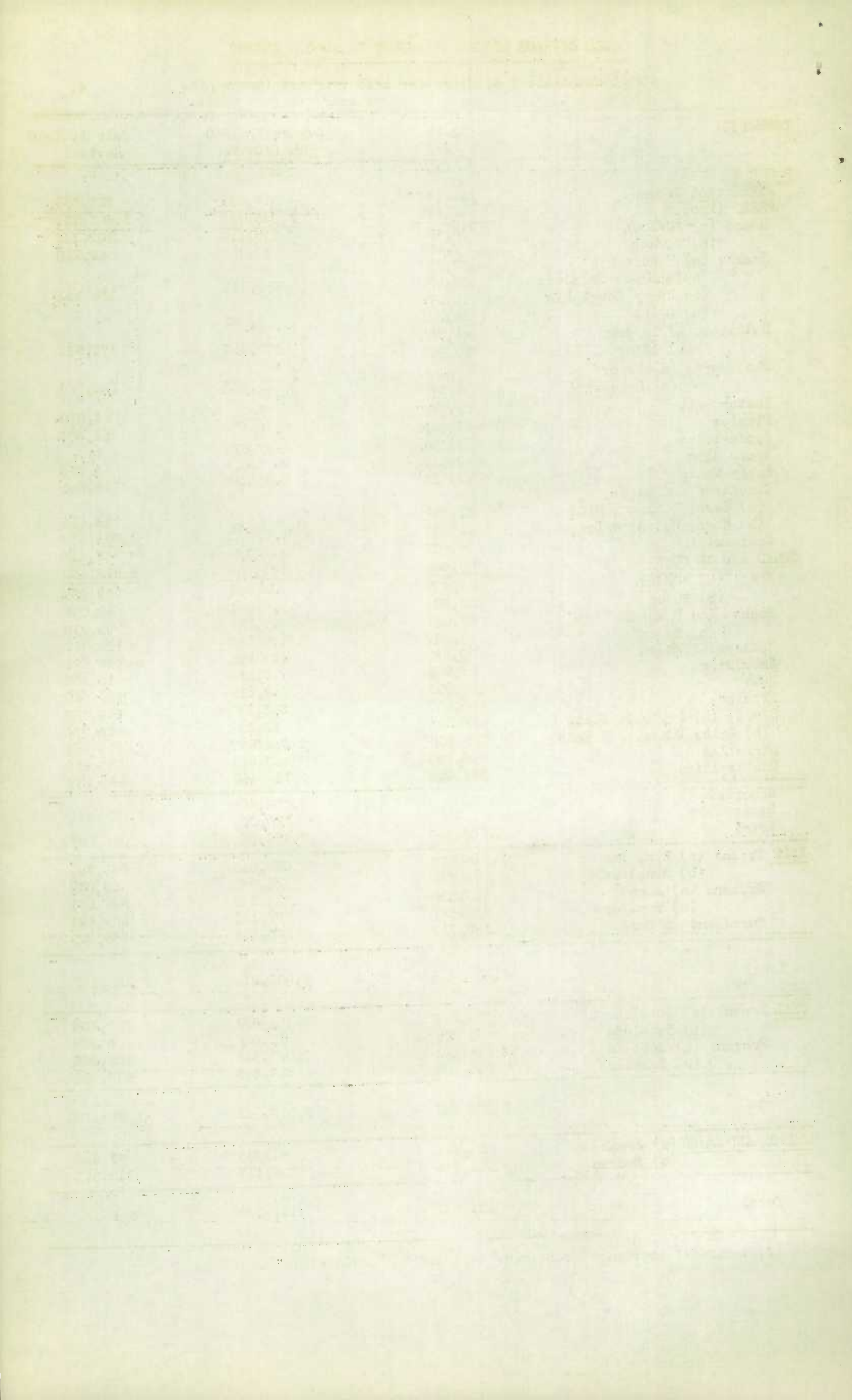
