



COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, SEPTEMBER 1, 1940

ALL MEAT.

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were 56,861,350 lb.

The reported stocks of Canadian meat amounted to 50,808,870 lb. With an addition of 4,678,000 lb. of estimated for firms failing to report on time, there was a total of 55,486,870 lb. There was an increase of 12.2 million lb. over the total Canadian meat stocks of a year ago, while during August 1940 there was a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 17.4 million lb.

PORK.

The reported holdings of Canadian pork were 34,187,630 lb. consisting of Fresh 4,175,338 lb; Frozen 8,065,745 lb; and Cured 21,946,547 lb. There was also an estimate of 3,571,000 lb. for late firms, which brought the Grand Total of Canadian pork to 37,758,630 lb. There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 15.9 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 4.4 million lb. last year.

There were additional reported holdings of Imported pork amounting to 1,167,462 lb.

LARD.

The reported holdings amounted to 3,188,865 lb. With an estimate of 700 thousand lb. for late firms the total, 3,088,865 lb. was 1.2 million lb. more than last year. The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 662 thousand lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.4 million lb.

BEEF.

The stocks of Canadian beef were reported as 11,948,661 lb. These consisted of 5,792,787 lb. Fresh; 4,283,144 lb. Frozen; 404,279 lb. Cured; and 1,468,451 lb. Fancy Meats. With an estimate of 351,000 lb. for firms failing to report in time, there was a Grand Total of 12,299,661 lb. These stocks are 12.4 per cent less than last month and show an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 1.7 million lb. compared with an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 1.1 million lb. a year ago. The holdings this year are 283 thousand lb. greater than last year.

In addition to the Canadian stocks there were reports of Imported Beef totalling 82,091 lb.

VEAL.

These stocks totalled 3,829,436 lb. as reported, being Fresh 803,485 lb; Frozen 2,667,975 lb; and Fancy Meats 357,976 lb. They are 9.3 per cent less than those of last month, there having been an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 398 thousand lb. during August 1940, while last year there was an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 42 thousand lb.

MUTTON AND LAMB. The holdings of Canadian as reported totalled 1,007,555 lb. consisting of Fresh 404,377 lb; Frozen 464,913 lb; and Fancy Meats 138,265 lb. The apparent net additions during August were 97 thousand lb. as compared with a net storage increase of 48 thousand lb. during August 1939.

There were reported stocks in addition of Imported mutton and lamb amounting to 124,927 lb.


