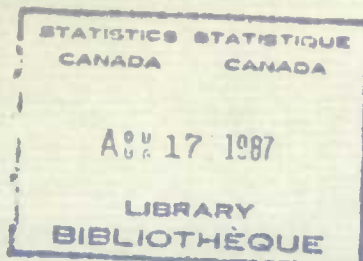

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, OCT. 1, 1941

ALL MEAT

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were 65,840,206 lb.

The reported stocks of Canadian meat amounted to 61,488,304 lb. With an addition of 3,627,000 lb. of estimates for firms failing to report on time, there was a total of 65,115,304 lb. There was an increase of 7.2 million lb. over the total Canadian meat stocks of a year ago, while during September 1941 there was a net "Into-Storage" movement of 6.8 million lb.

PORK

The reported holdings of Canadian pork were 35,952,208 lb. consisting of Fresh 5,263,269 lb.; Frozen 8,594,789 lb.; and Cured 22,094,150 lb. There was also an estimate of 2,157,000 lb. for late firms, which brought the Grand Total of Canadian pork to 38,109,208 lb. There was an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 1.1 million lb. as compared with an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 138 thousand lb. last year.

There were additional reported holdings of Imported Pork amounting to 560,313 lb.

LARD

The reported holdings amounted to 2,700,526 lb. Including an estimate of 189,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time, the Grand Total amounted to 2,889,526 lb. which were 609,690 lb. greater than last year. The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 1.1 million lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.7 million lb.

BEEF

The stocks of Canadian beef were reported as 17,419,915 lb. These consisted of 8,171,505 lb. Fresh; 6,912,378 lb. Frozen; 309,820 lb. Cured; and 2,026,212 lb. Fancy Meats. With an estimate of 1,226,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time, there was a Grand Total of 18,645,915 lb. These stocks are 24 per cent. greater than last month and show an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 3.7 million lb. compared with a similar movement of 1.3 million lb. a year ago. The holdings this year are 4.6 million lb. more than last year.

In addition to the Canadian Stocks there were reports of Imported Beef totalling 82,939 lb.

VEAL

These stocks totalled 5,860,563 lb. as reported, being Fresh 1,261,226 lb.; Frozen 4,184,058 lb.; and Fancy Meats 415,279 lb. Adding an estimate of 112,000 lb. for late firms, the Grand Total amounted to 5,972,563 lb. They are 18 per cent. greater than those of last month, there having been an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 912,000 lb. during September 1941, while last year there was a similar movement of 437,000 lb.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb as reported totalled 2,255,618 lb. consisting of Fresh 466,068 lb.; Frozen 1,630,705 lb.; and Fancy Meats 158,845 lb. The Grand Total was 2,387,618 lb. when 132,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time.

The apparent net increase during September was 1.2 million lb. as compared with a net storage increase of 377,000 lb. during September 1940.

There were reported stocks in addition of Imported mutton and lamb amounting to 81,650 lb.
