COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, NOV. 1, 1941

ALL MEAT

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were 87,320,681 lb. as compared with 68,811,303 lb. at the same date last year.

The reported stocks of Canadian meat amounted to 75,002,483 lb. With an addition of 11,765,000 lb. of estimates for firms failing to report on time, there was a total of 86,767,488 lb. There was an increase of 19.8 million lb. over the total Canadian meat stocks of a year ago, while during October 1941 there was a net "Into-Storage" movement of 22.6 million lb.

PORK

The reported holdings of Canadian pork were 40,532,374 lb. consisting of Fresh 5,966,577 lb; Frozen 8,107,289 lb; and Cured 26,458,208 lb. There was also an estimate of 7,425,000 lb. for late firms, which brought the Grand Total of Canadian pork to 47,957,374 lb. There was an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 10.2 million lb. as compared with an "Into-Storage" movement of 4.4 million lb. last year.

There were additional reported holdings of Imported Pork amounting to 280,126 lb.

LARD

The reported holdings amounted to 2,500,406 lb. Including an estimate of 700,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time, the Grand Total amounted to 3,200,406 lb. which were 914,000 lb. greater than last year. The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement was 392,000 lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 7,000 lb.

BEEF

The stocks of Canadian beef were reported as 23,189,593 lb. These consisted of 8,345,796 lb. Fresh; 12,549,396 lb. Frozen; 308,096 lb. Cured; and 1,986,305 lb. Fancy Meats. With an estimate of 2,505,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time, there was a Grand Total of 25,694,593 lb. These stocks are 39 per cent greater than last month and show an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 7.2 million lb. compared with a similar movement of 2.3 million lb. a year ago. The holdings this year are 9.4 million lb. greater than last year.

In addition to the Canadian Stocks there were reported holdings of Imported Beef totalling 192,053 1b.

VEAL

These stocks totalled 6,173,592 lb. as reported, being Fresh 1,075,724

1b; Frozen 4,689,058 lb; and Fancy Meats 408,810 lb. Adding an estimate of 883,000 lb.

for late firms, the Grand Total amounted to 7,056,592 lb. They are 16 per cent greater than those of last month, there having been an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 999,000 lb. during October 1941, while last year there was a similar movement of 610,000 lb.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb as Reported totalled 5,106,929

1b., consisting of Fresh 596,637 lb; Frozen 4,327,197 lb. and Fancy Meats 183,095 lb. The Grand Total was 5,577,929 lb. when 471,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time.

The apparent net increase during October was 3.2 million 1b. as compared with a net storage increase of 2.4 million 1b. during October 1940.

There were reported stocks in addition of Imported mutton and lamb amounting to 81,014 lb.




