

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, APRIL 1, 1941

ALL MEAT

The Grand lotal Stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were 97,638,504

The reported stocks of Canadian meat amounted to 94,910,695 lb. With an addition of 2,205,000 lb. of estimates for firms failing to report on time, there was a total of 97,115,695 lb. There was an increase of 5.3 million lb. over the total Canadian meat stocks of a year ago, while during March 1941 there was a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 2.8 million lb.

PORK

The reported holdings of Canadian pork were 74,781,624 lb. consisting of Fresh 6,478,155 lb; Frozen 40,443,193 lb; and Cured 27,860,276 lb. There was also an estimate of 1,560,000 lb. for late firms, which brought the Grand Total of Canadian pork to 76,341,624 lb. There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 618 thousand lb. as compared with an opposite movement of 3.2 million lb. last year.

There were additional reported holdings of Imported Pork amounting to 143,527 lb.

LARD

The reported holdings amounted to 7,276,385 lb. Including an estimate of 133,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time the Grand Total amounted to 7,409,385 lb. which were 3.5 million lb. greater than last year. The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement was 6 thousand lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 16 thousand lb.

BEEF

The stocks of Canadian beef were reported as 15,910,155 lb. These consisted of 6,853,195 lb. Fresh; 6,409,426 lb. Frozen; 524,132 lb. Cured; and 2,123,402 lb. Fancy Meats. With an estimate of 559,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time, there was a Grand Total of 16,469,155 lb. These stocks are 6.7 per cent less than last month and show an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 1.2 million lb. compared with a similar movement of 989 thousand lb. a year ago. The holdings this year are 9.1 million lb. less than last year.

In addition to the Canadian Stocks there were reports of Imported Beef totalling 20,774 lb.

VEAL


These stocks total led 1,719,920 lb. as reported, being Fresh 860,470 lb; Frozen 666,391 lb. and Fancy Meats 193,059 lb. Adding an estimate of 61,000 lb. for late firms, the Grand Total amounted to 1,780,920 lb. They are 3.7 per cent less than those of last month, there having been an apparent not "Out-of-Storage" movement of 68 thousand lb. during March 1941, while last year there was a similar movement of 435 thousand lb.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb as reported totalled 2,498,996 lb. consisting of Fresh 274,417 lb; Frozen 2,127,598 lb; and Fancy Meats 96,981 lb. The Grand Total was 2,523,996 lb. when 25,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time.

The apparent net decrease during March was 893 thousand 1b. as compared with a net storage decrease of 812 thousand 1b. during March 1940.


There were reported stocks in addition of Imported mutton and lamb amounting to 358,508 lb.
