

#### COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, MAY 1, 1941

#### ALL MEAT

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were

#### 87,766,903 lb.

The reported stocks of Canadian meat amounted to 82,023,304 lb. With an addition of 4,569,000 lb. of estimates for firms failing to report on time, there was a total of 86,592,304 lb. There was a decrease of 10.3 million lb. from the total Canadian meat stocks of a year ago, while during April 1941 there was a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 10.9 million lb.

#### PORK

The reported holdings of Canadian pork were 63,156,254 lb. consisting of Fresh 6,707,779 lb; Frozen 32,136,465 lb; and Cured 24,312,010 lb; There was also an estimate of 3,545,000 lb. for late firms, which brought the Grand Total of Canadian pork to 66,701,254 lb. There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 9.9 million lb. as compared with an "Into-Storage" movement of 8.0 million lb. last year.

There were additional reported holdings of Imported pork amounting to 465,672 lb.

#### LARD

The reported holdings amounted to 8,309,809 lb. Including an estimate of 228,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time the Grand Total amounted to 8,537,809 lb. which were 4.6 million lb. greater than last year. The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement was 1.1 million lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 59 thousand lb.

#### BEEF

The stocks of Canadian beef were reported as 14,172,117 lb. These consisted of 6,323,459 lb. Fresh; 5,583,985 lb. Frozen; 492,847 lb. Cured; and 1,771,826 lb. Fancy Meats. With an estimate of 725,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time, there was a Grand Total of 14,897,117 lb. These stocks are 9.3 per cent less than last month and show an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 1.5 million lb. compared with a similar movement of 2.6 million lb. a year ago. The holdings this year are 8.1 million lb. less than last year.

In addition to the Canadian Stocks there were reports of Imported Beef totalling 153,609 1b.

#### VEAL


These stocks totalled 2,877,747 lb. as reported, being Fresh 1,194,493 lb; Frozen 1,443,61l lb. and Fancy Meats 239,643 lb. Adding an estimate of 154,000 lb. for late firms, the Grand Total amounted to 3,031,747 lb. They are 71 per cent greater than those of last month, there having been an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 1.3 million lb. during April 1941, while last year there was a similar movement of 876 thousand lb.

#### MUTTON AND LAMB

The holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb as reported totalled 1,817,186 lb., consisting of Fresh 183,219 lb; Frozen 1,555,814 lb; and Fancy Meats 78,153 lb. The Grand Total was 1,962,186 lb. when 145,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time.

The apparent net decrease during April was 665 thousand lb. as compared with a net storage decrease of 1.2 million lb. during April 1940.


There were reported stocks in addition of Imported mutton and lamb amounting to 555,318 lb.
