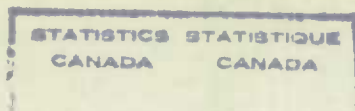

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, JUNE 1, 1941

ALL MEAT

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were
76,621,165 lb.

The reported stocks of Canadian meat amounted to 70,387,452 lb. With an addition of 5,227,000 lb. of estimates for firms failing to report on time, there was a total of 75,614,452 lb. There was a decrease of 21.6 million lb. from the total Canadian meat stocks of a year ago, while during May 1941 there was a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 11.8 million lb.

PORK

The reported holdings of Canadian pork were 51,936,642 lb. consisting of Fresh 4,594,179 lb; Frozen 26,455,764 lb; and Cured 20,386,699 lb. There was also an estimate of 4,189,000 lb. for late firms, which brought the Grand Total of Canadian pork to 56,125,642 lb. There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 11.4 million lb. as compared with an "Into-Storage" movement of 4.0 million lb. last year.

There were additional reported holdings of Imported pork amounting to
555,907 lb.

LARD

The reported holdings amounted to 8,310,497 lb. Including an estimate of 607,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time, the Grand Total amounted to 8,917,497 lb. which were 4.2 million lb. greater than last year. The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement was 354,000 lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 59 thousand lb.

BEEF

The stocks of Canadian beef were reported as 13,707,101 lb. These consisted of 6,964,233 lb. Fresh; 4,105,416 lb. Frozen; 586,171 lb. Cured; and 2,051,281 lb. Fancy Meats. With an estimate of 797,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time, there was a Grand Total of 14,504,101 lb. These stocks are 2.3 per cent less than last month and show an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 419,000 lb. compared with a similar movement of 3.8 million lb. a year ago. The holdings this year are 4.6 million lb. less than last year.

In addition to the Canadian Stocks there were reports of Imported Beef totalling 41,355 lb.

VEAL

These stocks totalled 3,704,679 lb. as reported, being Fresh 1,210,429 lb; Frozen 2,234,921 lb. and Fancy Meats 259,329 lb. Adding an estimate of 111,000 lb. for late firms, the Grand Total amounted to 3,815,679 lb. They are 25.6 per cent greater than those of last month, there having been an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 778 thousand lb. during May 1941, while last year there was an "Into-Storage" movement of 1.2 million lb.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb as reported totalled 1,039,030 lb., consisting of Fresh 189,349 lb; Frozen 796,339 lb; and Fancy Meats 53,342 lb. The Grand Total was 1,094,030 lb. when 55,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time.

The apparent net decrease during May was 892 thousand lb. as compared with a net storage decrease of 1.0 million lb. during May 1940.

There were reported stocks in addition of Imported Mutton and Lamb amounting to 409,451 lb.
