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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD SEPT. 1, 1941

ALL MEAT

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were 59,580,039 lb.

The reported stocks of Canadian meat amounted to 56,195,957 lb. With an addition of 2,215,000 lb. of estimates for firms failing to report on time, there was a total of 58,410,957 lb. There was an increase of 2,512,393 lb. from the total Canadian meat stocks of a year ago, while during August 1941 there was a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 3.4 million lb.

PORK

The reported holdings of Canadian pork were 35,467,798 lb. consisting of Fresh 4,350,916 lb.; Frozen 11,227,144 lb.; and Cured 19,889,738 lb. There was also an estimate of 1,501,000 lb. for late firms, which brought the Grand Total of Canadian pork to 36,968,798 lb. There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 15.6 million lb. last year.

There were additional reported holdings of Imported pork amounting to 509,216 lb.

LARD

The reported holdings amounted to 3,956,780 lb. Including an estimate of 75,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time, the Grand Total amounted to 4,031,780 lb. which were 73,445 lb. greater than last year. The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 790,532 lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 604,000 lb.

BEEF

The stocks of Canadian beef were reported as 14,527,676 lb. These consisted of 7,706,668 lb. Fresh; 4,457,508 lb. Frozen; 400,326 lb. Cured; and 1,962,974 lb. Fancy Meats. With an estimate of 551,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time, there was a Grand Total of 15,078,676 lb. These stocks are 3.4 per cent greater than last month and show an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 505,000 lb. compared with a similar movement of 1.3 million lb. a year ago. The holdings this year are 2,340,000 lb. greater than last year.

In addition to the Canadian stocks there were reports of Imported Beef totalling 44,725 lb.

VEAL

These stocks totalled 5,023,632 lb. as reported, being Fresh 935,373 lb.; Frozen 3,723,894 lb. and Fancy Meats 364,365 lb. Adding an estimate of 66,000 lb. for late firms the Grand Total amounted to 5,089,632 lb. They are 1.5 per cent less than those of last month, there having been an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 67,000 lb. during August 1941 while last year there was a similar movement of 306 thousand lb.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb as reported totalled 1,176,851 lb. consisting of Fresh 439,777 lb.; Frozen 638,563 lb.; and Fancy Meats 98,511 lb. The Grand Total was 1,186,851 lb. when 10,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time.

The apparent net increase during August was 252 thousand lb. as compared with a net storage increase of 147 thousand lb. during August 1940.

There were reported stocks in addition of Imported Mutton and Lamb amounting to 105,925 lb.
