# COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, JAN. 1, 1942

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

#### ALL MEAT

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were 116,234,132 lb. as compared with 32,288,436 lb. at the same date last year.

The reported stocks of Canadian meat amounted to 108,014,700 lb. With an addition of 7,426,000 lb. of estimates for firms failing to report on time, there was a total of 115,440,700 lb. There was an increase of 24.1 million lb. over the total Canadian meat stocks of a year ago, while during December 1941 there was a net "Into-Storage" movement of 5.3 million lb.

#### PORK

The reported holdings of Canadian pork were 64,690,383 lb. consisting of Fresh 5,476,365 lb; Frozen 31,725,426 lb; and Cured 27,468,590 lb. There was also an estimate of 5,745,000 lb. for late firms, which brought the Grand Total of Canadian pork to 70,435,383 lb. There was an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 10,4 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 7.0 million lb. last year.

There were, in addition, reported holdings of Imported Pork amounting to 83,023 lb.

#### LARD

The reported holdings amounted to 6,174,608 lb. Including an estimate of 632,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time, the Grand Total amounted to 6,806,608 lb. which were 2.0 million lb. greater than last year. The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement was 1.4 million lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.8 million lb.

#### BEEF

The stocks of Canadian beef were reported as 30,613,342 lb. These consisted of 6,325,391 lb. Fresh; 21,057,162 lb. Frozen; 609,916 lb. Cured; and 2,621,453 lb. Fancy Meats. With an estimate of 1,372,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time there was a Grand Total of 31,985,942 lb. These stocks are 8.3 per cent less than last month and show an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 2.9 million lb. compared with a similar movement of 405,000 lb. a year ago. The holdings this year are 10.2 million lb. greater than last year.

In addition to the Canadian stocks there were reported holdings of Imported Beef totalling 174,259 lb.

#### VEAL

These stocks totalled 5,999,959 lb. as reported, being Fresh 520,652 lb. Frozen 5,012,257 lb; and Fancy Meats 467,050 lb. Adding an estimate of 183,000 lb. for late firms, the Grand Total amounted to 6,182,959 lb. They are 21.8 per cent less than those of last month, there having been an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 1.7 million lb, during December 1941 while last year there was a similar movement of 1.3 million lb.

#### MUTTON AND LAMB

The holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb as reported totalled 6,710,416 lb. consisting of Fresh 238,602 lb; Frozen 6,222,169 lb. and Fancy Meats 249,445 lb. The Grand Total was 6,036,416 lb. when 126,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time.

The apparent net decrease during December was 514,000 lb. as compared with a net storage decrease of 481,000 lb. during December 1940.






