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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, OCTOBER 1, 1942

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The <u>Grand Total</u> stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were 40,379,139 lb. while last year at the same date this total was 66,098,832 lb.

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 40,162,916 lb. at October 1, 1942. Of this total there were 39,930,916 lb. of reported stocks and 232,000 lb. of estimates. for late firms. Last year the total was 65.3 million lb. while on September 1, 1942 the total was 40.3 million lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 183 thousand lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 7.0 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 28,832,114 lb. being 4,064,353 lb. Fresh; 4,941,117 lb. Frozen; and 19,826,644 lb. Cured. With an addition of 110,000 lb. as an estimate for late firms, the Grand Total was brought to 28,942,114 lb., which was an increase of 514 thousand lb, over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.3 million lb.

There were also holdings of Imported Pork amounting to 6,800 lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 5,186,085 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 5,196,085 lb. when 10,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 2.3 million lb. greater than last year. The movement for September 1942 was "Out-of-Storage" being 3.8 million lb., as compared with an "Out-of-Storage" movement a year ago of 1.2 million lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 6.789,115 lb, being classified as follows: 3,329,504 lb. Fresh; 2,112,388 lb. Frozen; 200,372 lb. Cured and 1,146,851 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 101,000 lb. the Grand Total was 6,890,115 lb. These stocks are 11.7 million lb. less than last year. Compared with last month they are 10.7 per cent less. The net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 826 thousand lb. while last year's figures showed an opposite movement of 3.5 million lb.

The reported stocks of Imported Beef totalled 146,160 lb.

VEAL.

The total holdings of Canadian veal amounted to 3,037,175 lb., including an estimate of 4,000 lb. for late firms. The <u>reported</u> holdings were 3,033,175 lb., being Fresh 842,184 lb; Frozen 2,006,723 lb; and Fancy Meats 184,268 lb. These stocks are 297 Thousand lb. or 8.8 per cent less than last month. In September 1941 the net "Into-Storage" movement was 992 thousand lb.

In addition there were 1,903 lb. of Imported Veal as reported.

MUTTON AND LAMB


The reported holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb were 1,276,512 lb., consisting of Fresh 402,407 lb; Frozen 774,140 lb; and Fancy Meats 99,965 lb. With an addition of 17,000 lb. for the estimate the Total was 1,293,512 lb., which was an increase of 426 thousand lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.2 million lb.

There were also holdings of Imported Mutton and Lamb amounting to 61,360 lb.
