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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, NOVEMBER 1, 1942

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were 59,548,663 lb. while last year at the same date this total was 92,562,830 lb.

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 59,460,190 lb. at November 1, 1942. Of this total there were 46,643,190 lb. of reported stocks and 12,817,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 91.8 million lb. while on October 1, 1942 the total was 40.1 million lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed a net "Into-Storage" movement of 19.4 million lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 26.5 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 29,253,456 lb. being 5,102,659 lb. Fresh; 4,023,227 lb. Frozen; and 20,127,570 lb. Cured. With an addition of Fresh 1,437,000; Frozen 922,000 and Cured 5,278,000 lb. or a total of 7,637,000 lb. as an estimate for late firms, the Grand Total was brought to 36,890,456 lb., which was an increase of 8.0 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 13.1 million lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 2,264,781 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 2,761,781 lb. when 497,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 588,000 lb. less than last year. The movement for October 1942 was "Out-of-Storage" being 2.4 million lb., as compared with an "Into-Storage" movement a year ago of 499 thousand lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 11,059,843 lb. being classified as follows: 6,381,616 lb. Fresh; 3,448,514 lb. Frozen; 385,539 lb. Cured and 844,174 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 4,167,000 lb. the Grand Total was 15,226,843 lb. These stocks are 11.8 million lb. less than last year. Compared with last month they are 124.7 per cent more. The net "Into-Storage" movement was 8.5 million lb. while last year's figures showed a similar movement of 8.4 million lb.

The reported stocks of Imported Beef totalled 53,761 lb.

VEAL

The total holdings of Canadian veal amounted to 3,394,620 lb., including an estimate of 411,000 lb. for late firms. The reported holdings were 2,983,620 lb., being Fresh 800,045 lb; Frozen 2,008,801 lb; and Fancy Meats 174,774 lb. These stocks are 337 Thousand lb. or 11 per cent more than last month. In October 1941 the net "Into-Storage" movement was 1.3 million lb.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb were 3,346,271 lb., consisting of Fresh 392,457 lb; Frozen 2,823,961 lb; and Fancy Meats 129,853 lb. With an addition of 602,000 lb. for the estimate the Total was 3,948,271 lb., which was an increase of 3.6 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 3.7 million lb.

There were also holdings of Imported Mutton and Lamb amounting to 34,712 lb.

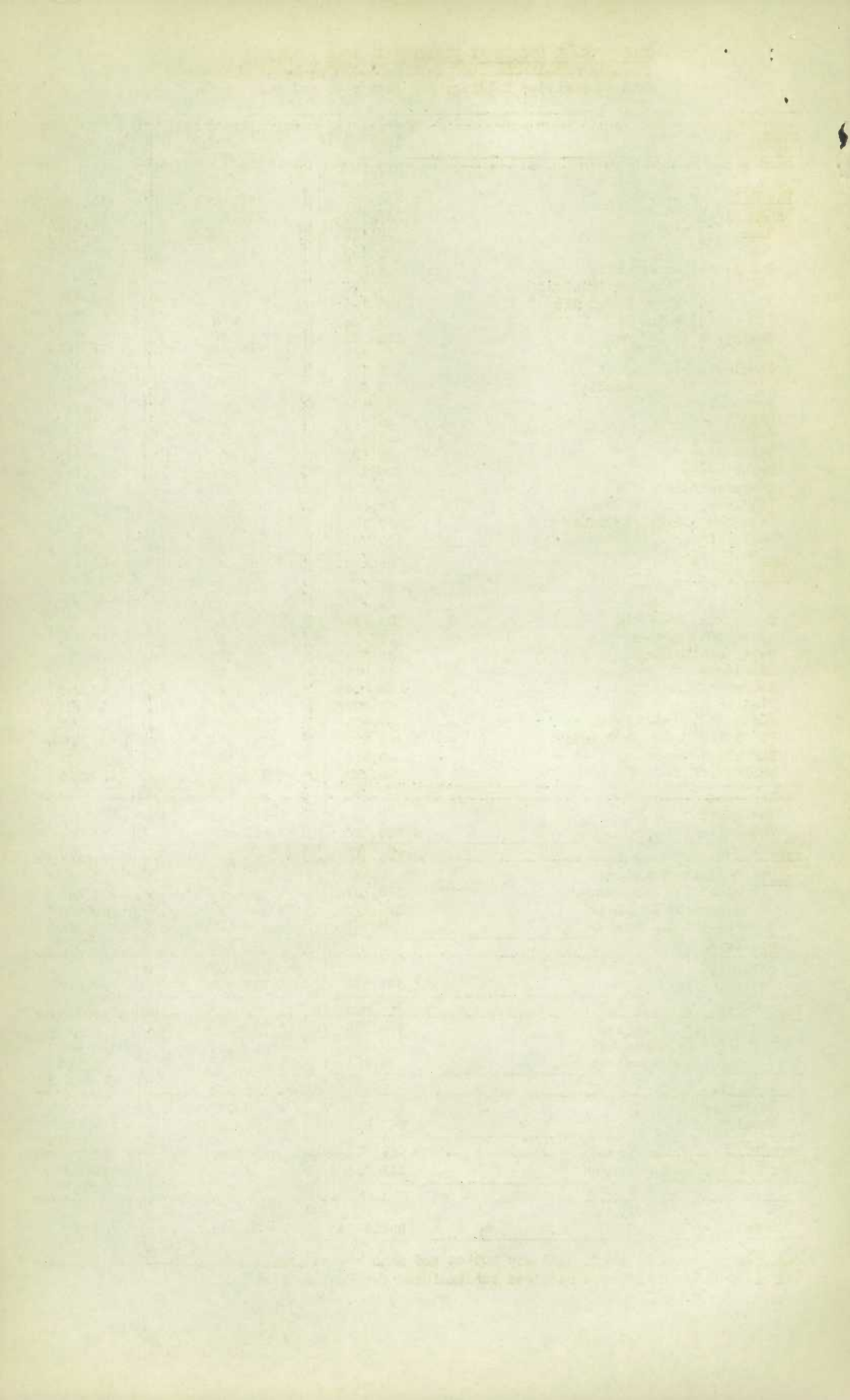
