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
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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, DECEMBER 1, 1942

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were 84,792,752 lb. while last year at the same date this total was 111,057,759 lb.

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 84,651,522 lb. at December 1, 1942. Of this total there were 81,693,522 lb. of reported stocks and 2,958,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 110,185,754 lb. while on November 1, 1942 the total was 60,202,068 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed a net "Into-Storage" movement of 24.4 million lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 18.4 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 46,415,689 lb., being 6,575,017 lb. Fresh; 9,048,722 lb. Frozen; and 30,791,950 lb. Cured. With an addition of 1,740,000 lb. as an estimate for late firms, the Grand Total was brought to 48,155,689 lb., which was an increase of 11.1 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 8.7 million lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 2,277,425 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 2,336,425 lb. when 59,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 3.1 million lb. less than last year. The movement for November 1942 was "Out-of-Storage", being 436,273 lb., as compared with an "Into-Storage" movement a year ago of 2.1 million lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 26,599,338 lb. being classified as follows: 7,552,021 lb. Fresh; 16,714,364 lb. Frozen; 496,379 lb. Cured and 1,836,574 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 1,000,000 lb. the Grand Total was 27,599,338 lb. These stocks are 7.3 million lb. less than last year. Compared with last month they are 76.5 per cent more. The net "Into-Storage" movement was 12 million lb. while last year's figures showed a similar movement of 7.9 million lb.

The reported stocks of Imported Beef totalled 118,336 lb.

VEAL


The total holdings of Canadian veal amounted to 3,432,144 lb., including an estimate of 64,000 lb. for late firms. The reported holdings were 3,368,144 lb., being Fresh 812,579 lb; Frozen 2,347,490 lb; and Fancy Meats 208,075 lb. These stocks are 101,434 lb., or 2.9 per cent less than last month. In November 1941 the net "Into-Storage" movement was 522 thousand lb.

Reported stocks of Imported veal were 11,772 lb.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb were 5,310,351 lb., consisting of Fresh 362,245 lb; Frozen 4,797,520 lb; and Fancy Meats 150,586 lb. With an addition of 111,000 lb. for the estimate the Total was 5,421,351 lb., which was an increase of 1.5 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.3 million lb.

There were also holdings of Imported Mutton and Lamb amounting to 10,522 lb.


