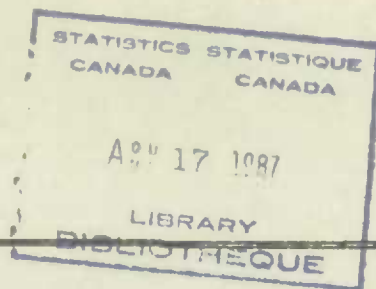

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, FEB. 1, 1942

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were 121,244,672 lb. as compared with 98,565,940 lb. at the same date last year.

The reported stocks of Canadian meat amounted to 114,341,291 lb. With an addition of 5,998,000 lb. of estimates for firms failing to report on time, there was a total of 120,339,291 lb. There was an increase of 22.4 million lb. over the total Canadian meat stocks of a year ago, while during January 1942 there was a net "Into-Storage" movement of 4.1 million lb.

PORK

The reported holdings of Canadian pork were 71,269,566 lb. consisting of Fresh 5,766,497 lb; Frozen 36,524,777 lb; and Cured 28,978,292 lb. There was also an estimate of 3,839,000 lb. for late firms, which brought the Grand Total of Canadian pork to 75,108,566 lb. There was an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 3.9 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 9.9 million lb. last year.

There were, in addition, reported holdings of Imported Pork amounting to 278,435 lb.

LARD

The reported holdings amounted to 6,372,472 lb. Including an estimate of 348,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time, the Grand Total amounted to 6,720,472 lb. which were 1.2 million lb. greater than last year. The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement was 49 thousand lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 642 thousand lb.

BEEF

The stocks of Canadian beef were reported as 31,834,598 lb. These consisted of 9,400,231 lb. Fresh; 19,043,855 lb. Frozen; 718,854 lb. Cured and 2,671,658 lb. Fancy Meats. With an estimate of 1,673,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time there was a Grand Total of 33,507,598 lb. These stocks are 4.8 per cent greater than last month and show an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 1.5 million lb. compared with an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 1.6 million lb. a year ago. The holdings this year are 13.3 million lb. greater than last year.

In addition to the Canadian stocks there were reported holdings of Imported Beef totalling 360,690 lb.

VEAL

These stocks totalled 4,546,915 lb. as reported, being Fresh 655,297 lb. Frozen 3,491,573 lb; and Fancy Meats 400,045 lb. Adding an estimate of 166 thousand lb. for late firms, the Grand Total amounted to 4,712,915 lb. They are 24.3 per cent less than those of last month, there having been an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 1.5 million lb. during January 1942 while last year there was a similar movement of 993 thousand lb. There were reported stocks in addition of Imported Veal amounting to 110,034 lb.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb as reported totalled 6,690,212 lb. consisting of Fresh 457,111 lb; Frozen 6,023,629 lb. and Fancy Meats 209,472 lb. The Grand Total was 7,010,212 lb. when 320,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time.

The apparent net increase during January was 219,000 lb. as compared with a net storage decrease of 773,000 lb. during January 1941.

There were reported stocks in addition of Imported mutton and lamb amounting to 156,222 lb.
