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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, APRIL 1, 1942

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were 103,523,239 lb. while last year at the same date they amounted to 98,150,178 lb.

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 103,071,131 lb. Of this total there were 97,477,831 lb. of reported stocks and 5,593,300 lb. of estimates for late firms. The Canadian meat stocks show an excess of 5.5 million lb. over those of a year ago. During March 1942 there was a net decrease of 4.8 million lb.

PORK

The Total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 70,297,623 lb. being 5,679,192 lb. Fresh; 35,171,333 lb. Frozen; and 29,447,098 lb. Cured. With an addition of 3,320,000 lb. as an estimate for late firms the Grand Total was brought to 73,617,623 lb. which was an increase of 1.8 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 377,000 lb.

There were also holdings of Imported Pork amounting to 192,564 lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 8,280,550 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 8,929,550 lb. when 649,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 1.4 million lb. greater than last year. The Storage movements for last year and this show net increases of 80,000 lb. for March 1941 and 1.4 million lb. for March 1942.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 20,193,525 lb. being classified as follows: 5,505,702 lb. Fresh; 11,815,223 lb. Frozen; 836,037 lb. Cured and 2,036,563 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 1,541,000 lb. the Grand Total was 21,734,525 lb. These stocks are 5.2 million lb. greater than last year. Compared with last month they are 19.6 per cent less. The net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 5.3 million lb. while last year's figures showed a similar movement of 1.2 million lb.

The reported stocks of Imported Beef totalled 108,241 lb.

VEAL

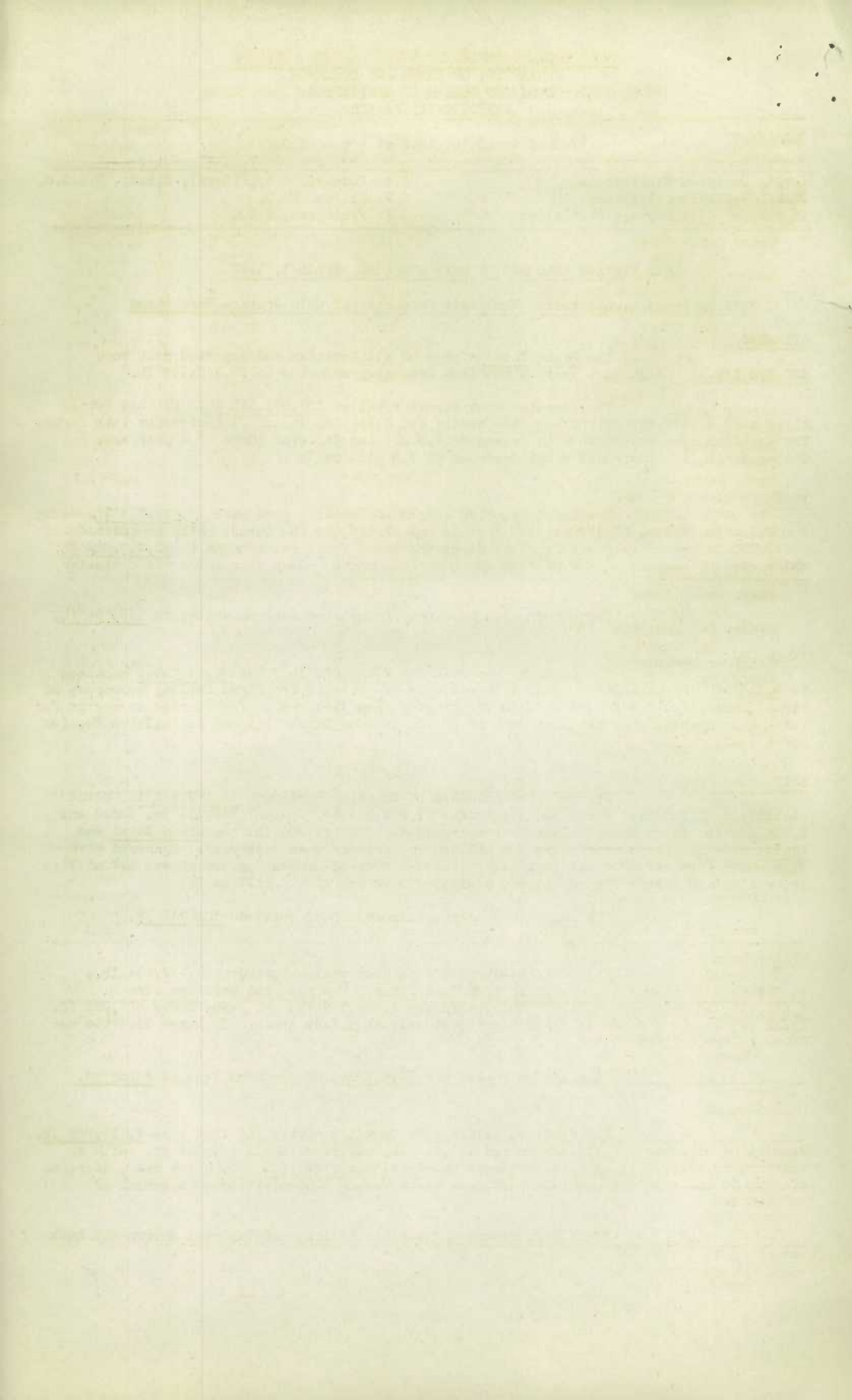
The Total holdings of Canadian veal amounted to 2,777,314 lb., including an estimate of 208,300 lb. for late firms. The reported holdings were 2,569,014 lb., being Fresh 1,047,503 lb.; Frozen 1,294,119 lb.; and Fancy Meats 227,392 lb. These stocks are 306,000 lb. or 9.9 per cent less than last month. In March 1941 the net "Out-of-Storage" was 90,000 lb.

In addition there were 83,602 lb. of Imported Veal as reported.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb were 4,417,669 lb., consisting of Fresh 245,299 lb.; Frozen 461,518 lb.; and Fancy Meats 110,852 lb. With an addition of 524,000 lb. for the estimate the Total was 4,941,669 lb., which was a decrease of 967,000 lb. from last month. Last year there was an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 792,000 lb.

There were reported stocks in addition of Imported Mutton and Lamb amounting to 67,701 lb.
