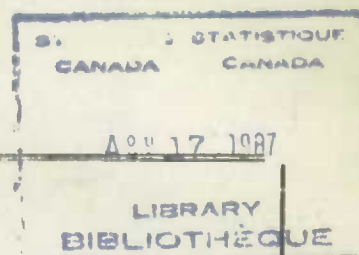

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, JULY 1, 1942

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were 57,161,163 lb. while last year at the same date this total was 68,581,877 lb.

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 56,797,932 lb. at July 1, 1942. Of this total there were 54,196,932 lb. of reported stocks and 2,601,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. The Canadian meat stocks showed a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 18.2 million lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 8.0 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 39,571,653 lb. being 4,279,854 lb. Fresh; 12,559,702 lb. Frozen; and 22,732,097 lb. Cured. With an addition of 2,100,000 lb. as an estimate for late firms, the Grand Total was brought to 41,671,653 lb. which was a decrease of 16.6 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 8.1 million lb.

There were also holdings of Imported Pork amounting to 58,400 lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 12,139,376 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 12,559,376 lb. when 420,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 5.2 million lb. greater than last year. The movement for June 1942 of 1.7 million lb. was Into-Storage being 283,000 lb. as contrasted with the Out-of-Storage movement a year ago of 1.7 million lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 10,005,175 lb. being classified as follows: 4,347,839 lb. Fresh; 3,925,132 lb. Frozen; 217,567 lb. Cured and 1,514,637 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 428,000 lb. the Grand Total was 10,433,175 lb. These stocks are 3.6 million lb. less than last year. Compared with last month they are 10 per cent less. The net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 1.2 million lb. while last year's figures showed a similar movement of 654,000 lb.

The reported stocks of Imported Beef totalled 150,549 lb.

VEAL

The total holdings of Canadian veal amounted to 3,750,603 lb., including an estimate of 65,000 lb. for late firms. The reported holdings were 3,685,603 lb., being Fresh 1,045,497 lb; Frozen 2,378,501 lb; and Fancy Meats 261,605 lb. These stocks are 236,000 lb. or 6.7 per cent more than last month. In June 1941 the net "Into-Storage" movement was 949,000 lb.

In addition there were 77,843 lb. of Imported Veal as reported.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb were 934,501 lb., consisting of Fresh 207,361 lb; Frozen 658,653 lb; and Fancy Meats 68,487 lb. With an addition of 8,000 lb. for the estimate the Total was 942,501 lb., which was a decrease of 679,000 lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 259,000 lb.

There were reported stocks in addition of Imported Mutton and Lamb amounting to 76,439 lb.
