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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, DECEMBER 1, 1943

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

P O R K The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 69,373,704 lb.; being 9,439,723 lb. Fresh; 24,177,546 lb. Frozen; and 35,756,435 lb. Cured. With an addition of 1,375,000 lb. as an estimate for late firms, the Grand Total was brought to 70,748,704 lb. which was an increase of 11.8 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 11.3 million lb.

Stocks of Imported pork totalled 570,205 lb.

LARD The quantity reported was 3,113,637 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 3,260,637 lb. when 147,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 909 thousand lb. more than last year. The movement for November 1943 was "Into-Storage", being 705 thousand lb. Last year there was an opposite movement of 412 thousand lb.

BEEF The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 29,554,023 lb. being classified as follows: 8,257,230 lb. Fresh; 19,285,288 lb. Frozen; 671,329 lb. Cured and 1,340,176 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 650,000 lb. the Grand Total was 30,204,023 lb. These stocks are 2.2 million lb. more than last year. Compared with last month they are 37.4 per cent more. The net "Into-Storage" movement was 8.2 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 12.3 million lb.

VEAL The total holdings of Canadian veal amounted to 6,230,735 lb., including an estimate of 60,000 lb. for late firms. The reported holdings were 6,170,735 lb., being Fresh 923,608 lb.; Frozen 5,153,954 lb.; and Fancy Meats 93,173 lb. These stocks are 194,000 lb. more than last month and 2.7 million lb. more than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB The reported holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb were 7,947,863 lb. consisting of Fresh 581,404 lb., Frozen 7,263,618 lb. and Fancy Meats 102,841 lb. With an addition of 37,000 lb. as an estimate for late firms the total stocks were 7,984,863 lb. These figures show an increase of 3.5 million lb. over last month. Last year there was also an increase of 1.5 million lb.
