

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, FEBRUARY 1, 1943

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were 78,916,652 lb. while last year at the same date this total was 122,618,250 lb.

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 78,809,937 lb. at February 1, 1943. Of this total there were 71,731,937 lb. of reported stocks and 7,078,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 121,584,472 lb. while on January 1, 1943 the total was 92,153,415 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 13.3 million lb. while a year ago there was an opposite movement of 5.3 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 50,094,848 lb. being 5,432,456 lb. Fresh; 25,290,678 lb. Frozen; and 19,371,714 lb. Cured. With an addition of 6,090,000 lb. as an estimate for late firms, the Grand Total was brought to 56,184,848 lb. which was an increase of 535 thousand lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 4.4 million lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 1,872,309 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 2,012,309 lb. when 140,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 4.8 million lb. less than last year. The movement for January 1943 was "Out-of-Storage", being 839 thousand lb. Last year there was an opposite movement of 154 thousand lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 17,374,121 lb. being classified as follows: 2,934,120 lb. Fresh; 12,343,228 lb. Frozen; 509,255 lb. Cured and 1,587,518 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 874,000 lb. the Grand Total was 18,248,121 lb. These stocks are 15.8 million lb. less than last year. Compared with last month they are 37.5 per cent less. The net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 11.0 million lb. while last year's figures showed an opposite movement of 2.0 million lb.

The reported stocks of Imported Beef totalled 12,369 lb.

VEAL

The total holdings of Canadian veal amounted to 1,168,284 lb. including an estimate of 20,000 lb. for late firms. The reported holdings were 1,148,284 lb. being Fresh 213,726 lb., Frozen 864,466 lb. and Fancy Meats 70,092 lb. These stocks are 1.1 million lb. or 49.3 per cent less than last month. In January 1942 the net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 1.5 million lb.

There were also holdings of Imported Veal amounting to 94,346 lb.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb were 3,114,684 lb. consisting of Fresh 98,270 lb., Frozen 2,944,075 lb. and Fancy Meats 72,339 lb. With an addition of 94,000 lb. for the estimate the Total was 3,208,684 lb., which was a decrease of 1.8 million lb. from last month. Last year there was an increase of 252 thousand lb.


