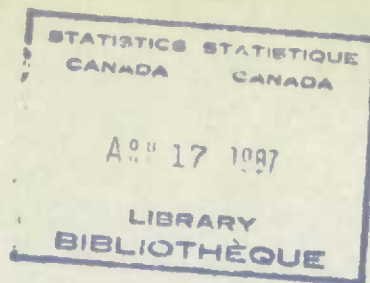

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, JULY 1, 1943

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were 67,022,031 lb. while last year at the same date this total was 57,491,034 lb.

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 66,862,798 lb. at July 1, 1943. Of this total there were 65,195,798 lb. of reported stocks and 1,467,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 57,127,803 lb. while on June 1, 1943 the total was 73,924,883 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 7.3 million lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 18.1 million lb.

P O R K

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 46,175,188 lb. being 5,907,957 lb. Fresh; 18,064,835 lb. Frozen; and 22,202,396 lb. Cured. With an addition of 1,260,000 lb. as an estimate for late firms, the Grand Total was brought to 47,435,188 lb. which was a decrease of 6.5 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 16.4 million lb.

Stocks of Imported pork totalled 249,201 lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 3,043,517 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 3,167,517 lb. when 124,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 9.3 million lb. less than last year. The movement for June 1943 was "Into-Storage", being 395,705 lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 222 thousand lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 13,497,183 lb. being classified as follows: 4,480,942 lb. Fresh; 6,881,495 lb. Frozen; 793,585 lb. Cured and 1,341,161 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 187,000 lb. the Grand Total was 13,684,183 lb. These stocks are 3.1 million lb. more than last year. Compared with last month they are 9.6 per cent less. The net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 1.5 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 1.3 million lb.

The reported stocks of Imported Beef totalled 85,836 lb.

VEAL

The total holdings of Canadian veal amounted to 4,963,905 lb. including an estimate of 20,000 lb. for late firms. The reported holdings were 4,943,905 lb. being Fresh 953,519 lb.; Frozen 3,902,501 lb.; and Fancy Meats 87,885 lb. These stocks are 846 thousand lb. or 20.3 per cent more than last month. In June 1942 the net "Into-Storage" movement was 259 thousand lb.

There were also holdings of Imported Veal amounting to 24,196 lb.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The total holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb were 579,522 lb. consisting of Fresh 156,251 lb., Frozen 386,440 lb. and Fancy Meats 36,831 lb. These figures show a decrease of 142 thousand lb. from last month. Last year there was a decrease of 673 thousand lb.
