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### COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, OCTOBER 1, 1944

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were 67,456,295 lb. while last year at the same date this total was 68,318,473 lb. and last month 70,673,418 lb.

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 67,286,704 lb.

Of this total there were 63,146,704 lb. of reported stocks and 4,140,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 67,802,715 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 7.2 million lb. while a year ago there was an opposite movement of 3.7 million lb.

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 33,602,208 lb.; being 5,057,953 lb. Fresh; 8,813,515 lb. Frozen; and 19,730,740 lb. Cured. With an addition of 1,610,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 35,212,208 lb. which was a decrease of 5.5 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 954 thousand lb.

Stocks of Imported pork totalled 169,591 lb.

The quantity reported was 6,824,091 lb. The Grand

Total amounted to 269,091 lb. when 445,000 lb.

were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 5.2

million lb. more than last year. The movement for September 1944 was "Out-of-Storage",

being 5.6 million lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 982 thousand lb.

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 20,649,315 lb. being classified as follows: 7,765,888 lb. Fresh: 9,565,411 lb. Frozen; 1,017,803 lb. Cured and 2,300,213 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 2,010,000 lb. the Grand Total was 22,659,315 lb. These stocks were 3.6 million lb. more than last year. The net "Into-Storage" movement was 1.3 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 3.7 million lb.

The total holdings of Canadian veal amounted to 6,534,280 lb., including an estimate of 320,000 lb. for late firms. The reported holdings were 6,214,280 lb., being Fresh 1,060,128 lb.; Frozen 5,027,575 lb.; and Fancy Meats 126,577 lb. These stocks are 110 thousand lb. more than last month and 959 thousand lb. more than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The total holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb are 2,880,901 lb. consisting of Fresh 659,438 lb.,
Frozen 1,853,827 lb. and Fancy Meat 167,636 lb. These figures show an increase of 961 thousand lb. over last month. Last year there was an increase of 667 thousand lb.

EDIBLE TALLON Stocks on October 1 were 4,692,238 lb. as compared with 5,482,563 lb. on September 1.
