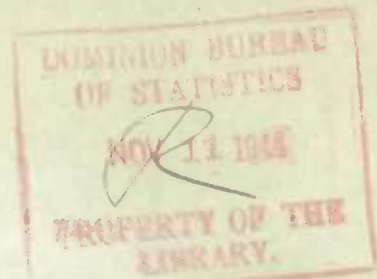

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, NOVEMBER 1, 1944

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were 78,728,483 lb. while last year at the same date this total was 91,928,532 lb. and last month 70,756,696 lb.

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 78,717,890 lb. Of this total there were 75,877,890 lb. of reported stocks and 2,840,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 91,441,799 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Into-Storage" movement of 8.1 million lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 23.6 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 40,231,784 lb; being 6,757,952 lb. Fresh; 6,506,768 lb. Frozen; and 26,967,064 lb. Cured. With an addition of 2,365,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 42,596,784 lb. which was an increase of 6.1 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 17.5 million lb.

Stocks of Imported pork totalled 10,593 lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 4,144,066 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 4,454,066 lb. when 310,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 1.9 million lb. more than last year. The movement for October 1944 was "Out-of-Storage", being 2.8 million lb. Last year there was an opposite movement of 511 thousand lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 24,299,858 lb. being classified as follows: 8,930,438 lb. Fresh; 11,086,142 lb. Frozen; 1,011,417 lb. Cured and 3,271,861 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 425,000 lb. the Grand Total was 24,724,858 lb. These stocks were 2.7 million lb. more than last year. The net "Into-Storage" movement was 100,000 lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 2.9 million lb.

VEAL

The total holdings of Canadian veal amounted to 6,762,527 lb. including an estimate of 50,000 lb. for late firms. The reported holdings were 6,712,527 lb., being Fresh 1,253,409 lb.; Frozen 5,299,980 lb; and Fancy Meats 159,138 lb. These stocks are 179 thousand lb. more than last month and 725 thousand lb. more than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The total holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb are 4,633,721 lb. consisting of Fresh 489,685 lb; Frozen 3,998,916 lb. and Fancy Meats 145,120 lb. These figures show an increase of 1.8 million lb. over last month. Last year there was an increase of 151 thousand lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on November 1 were 4,470,012 lb. as compared with 4,600,997 lb. on October 1.
