

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, DECEMBER 1, 1944

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

There were no stocks of imported meat on December 1. The Canadian meat stocks totalled 91,962,783 lb. Of this total there were 82,612,783 lb. of reported stocks and 9,350,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 115,555,079 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Into-Storage" movement of 12.1 million lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 24.1 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 42,851,041 lb.; being 8,003,469 lb. Fresh; 6,871,220 lb. Frozen; and 27,976,352 lb. Cured. With an addition of 4,030,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 46,881,041 lb. which was an increase of 3.8 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 12.0 million lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 3,939,488 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 4,403,488 lb. when 464,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 1.1 million lb. more than last year. The movement for November 1944 was "Out-of-Storage", being 155 thousand lb. Last year there was an opposite movement of 768 thousand lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 27,619,414 lb. being classified as follows: 10,046,407 lb. Fresh; 13,234,510 lb. Frozen; 655,965 lb. Cured and 3,682,532 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 4,980,000 lb. the Grand Total was 32,599,414 lb. These stocks were 2.3 million lb. more than last year. The net "Into-Storage" movement was 7.4 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 8.3 million lb.

VEAL

The total holdings of Canadian veal amounted to 6,385,966 lb. including an estimate of 140,000 lb. for late firms. The reported holdings were 6,245,966 lb., being Fresh 895,475 lb.; Frozen 5,210,846 lb.; and Fancy Meats 139,645 lb. These stocks are 591 thousand lb. less than last month and 91 thousand lb. more than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The total holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb are 6,096,362 lb., consisting of Fresh 509,137 lb; Frozen 5,169,845 lb. and Fancy Meats 137,380 lb. These figures show an increase of 1.4 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 3.5 million lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on December 1 were 4,562,851 lb. as compared with 4,470,312 lb. on November 1.
