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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, FEBRUARY 1, 1944

P O R K

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 81,091,209 lb.; being 10,059,247 lb. Fresh; 37,206,817 lb. Frozen; and 33,825,145 lb. Cured. With an addition of 6,655,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 87,746,209 lb. which was an increase of 2.6 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 511 thousand lb.

Stocks of Imported pork totalled 436,368 lb.

L A R D

The quantity reported was 8,821,805 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 9,242,805 lb. when 421,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 7.2 million lb. more than last year. The movement for January 1944 was "Into-Storage", being 3.8 million lb. Last year there was an opposite movement of 825 thousand lb.

B E E F

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 37,701,166 lb. being classified as follows: 8,877,387 lb. Fresh; 25,498,094 lb. Frozen; 1,788,108 lb. Cured and 1,537,577 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 1,435,000 lb. the Grand Total was 39,136,166 lb. These stocks are 20.8 million lb. more than last year. Compared with last month they are 9.4 per cent more. The net "Into-Storage" movement was 3.5 million lb. Last year's figures showed an opposite movement of 10.8 million lb.

V E A L

The total holdings of Canadian veal amounted to 4,352,853 lb., including an estimate of 30,000 lb. for late firms. The reported holdings were 4,322,853 lb., being Fresh 423,306 lb.; Frozen 3,829,490 lb.; and Fancy Meats 70,057 lb. These stocks are 1.1 million lb. less than last month and 3.2 million lb. more than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb are 8,788,089 lb. consisting of Fresh 464,855 lb., Frozen 8,261,485 lb. and Fancy Meats 61,749 lb. With an addition of 230,000 lb. as an estimate for late firms the total stocks were 9,018,089 lb. These figures show a decrease of 400 thousand lb. from last month. Last year there was a decrease of 1.8 million lb.
