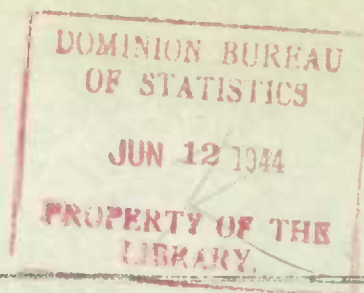

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, JUNE 1, 1944

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

P O R K

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 76,290,575 lb.; being 7,863,137 lb. Fresh; 40,201,879 lb. Frozen; and 28,225,559 lb. Cured. With an addition of 9,980,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 86,270,575 lb. which was a decrease of 13 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 987 thousand lb.

Stocks of Imported pork totalled 327,659 lb.

L A R D

The quantity reported was 19,033,298 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 20,878,298 lb. when 1,745,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 18.1 million lb. more than last year. The movement for May 1944 was "Into-Storage", being 8 thousand lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 655 thousand lb.

B E E F

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 23,764,562 lb. being classified as follows: 5,873,398 lb. Fresh; 14,438,483 lb. Frozen; 1,147,369 lb. Cured and 2,305,312 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 1,285,000 lb. the Grand Total was 25,049,562 lb. These stocks are 9.9 million lb. more than last year. The net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 6.1 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 2.5 million lb.

V E A L

The total holdings of Canadian veal amounted to 5,621,906 lb., including an estimate of 137,000 lb. for late firms. The reported holdings were 5,484,906 lb., being Fresh 1,052,295 lb.; Frozen 4,305,853 lb.; and Fancy Meats 126,758 lb. These stocks are 1.0 million lb. more than last month and 1.5 million lb. more than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb are 3,656,613 lb. consisting of Fresh 93,102 lb., Frozen 3,492,422 lb. and Fancy Meats 71,089 lb. With an addition of 138,000 lb. as an estimate for late firms the total stocks were 3,794,613 lb. These figures show a decrease of 1.8 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a decrease of 812 thousand lb.
