

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD. JULY 1. 1944

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported mest were 104, 89,885 lb. while last year at the same dat.

this total was 70,268,130 lb.

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 104,044,114 lb. at July 1, 1944. Of this total there were 97,539 114 lb. of reported stocks and 6,505,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 69,908,897 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 17 million 1b, while a year ago there was a similar movement of 4.1 million 1b.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 69,572,106 lb.; being 6,797,804 lb. Fresh; 37,532,352 lb. Frozen; and 25,241,950 lb. Cured. With an addition of 5,635,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 75,207,106 lb, which was a decrease of 11,6 million lb. from last month, Last year there was a similar movement of 4.0 million 1b,

Stocks of Imported pork totalled 245,771 lb.

LARD
The quantity reported was 18,685,824 lb. The Grand
Total amounted to 20,050,824 lb. when 1,355,000 lb.
were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 16.8 million 1b. more than last year. The movement for June 1944 was "Out-of-Storage", being 690 thousand 1b. Last year there was an opposite movement of 483 thousand 1b.

BEEF The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 19,296,308 1b. being classified as follows: 5,249,367 lb. Fresh; 10,875,645 lb. Frozen; 1,198,868 lb. Cured and 1,972,428 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 825,000 lb. the Grand Total was 20,121,308 lb. These stocks were 5.9 million lb. more than last year. The net "Out-of-Storage" movement as 5,1 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 907 thousand 1b.

The total holdings of Canadian veal amounted to VEAL 5,932,536 lb., including an estimate of 45,000 lb. for late firms. The reported holdings were 5,887,536 lb., being Fresh 950,298 lb.; Frozen 4,835,846 lb.; and Fancy Meats 101,392 lb. These stocks are 274,000 lb. more than last month and 844 thousand lb. more than last year's holdings.

The total holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb are MUTTON AND LAMB 2,783,164 lb. consisting of Fresh 185,410 lb., Frozen 2,451,795 lb, and Fancy Meats 145,959 lb, These figures show a decrease of 1.0 million 1b. from last month, Last year there was a decrease of 128 thousand 1b.
