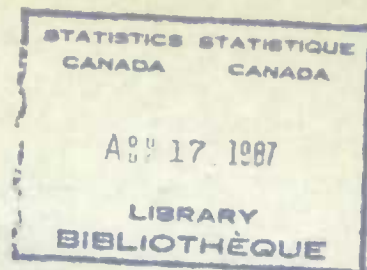

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, SEPTEMBER 1, 1944

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were 69,749,764 lb. while last year at the same date this total was 65,017,623 lb. and last month 69,231,593 lb.

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 69,595,357 lb. of this total there were 66,805,857 lb. of reported stocks and 2,790,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 64,093,037 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 19.4 million lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 1.6 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 38,159,080 lb.; being 4,408,197 lb. Fresh; 14,554,616 lb. Frozen; and 19,196,267 lb. Cured. With an addition of 1,990,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 40,149,080 lb. which was a decrease of 20 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 3.9 million lb.

Stocks of Imported pork totalled 153,907 lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 12,560,229 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 12,760,229 lb. when 200,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 9.7 million lb. more than last year. The movement for August 1944 was "Out-of-Storage", being 3.7 million lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 809 thousand lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 20,480,627 lb. being classified as follows: 7,169,775 lb. Fresh; 9,885,664 lb. Frozen; 1,130,735 lb. Cured and 2,294,453 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 770,000 lb. the Grand Total was 21,250,627 lb. These stocks were 6 million lb. more than last year. The net "Into-Storage" movement was 924 thousand lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 1.9 million lb.

VEAL

The total holdings of Canadian veal amounted to 6,324,978 lb., including an estimate of 30,000 lb. for last firms. The reported holdings were 6,294,978 lb., being Fresh 1,023,121 lb.; Frozen 5,125,680 lb.; and Fancy Meats 146,177 lb. These stocks are 66 thousand lb. less than last month and 1.0 million lb. more than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The total holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb are 1,871,172 lb. consisting of Fresh 425,194 lb., Frozen 1,333,848 lb. and Fancy Meats 112,130 lb. These figures show a decrease of 206 thousand lb. from last month. Last year there was an increase of 296 thousand lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

For the first time stocks of this commodity are published here. On August 1 stocks were Beef Tallow 4,671,739 lb. and on September 1, 4,757,008 lb. Mutton Tallow on August 1 was 276,341 lb. and on September 1, 41,724 lb.
