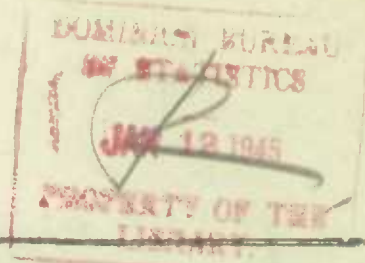

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, JANUARY 1, 1945

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 90,180,535 lb. Of this total there were 83,820,535 lb. of reported stocks and 6,360,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 145,541,531 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of only 400 thousand lb. while a year ago there was an opposite movement of 30 million lb.

There were no stocks of imported meat on January 1.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 43,494,827 lb.; being 6,813,051 lb. Fresh; 8,343,634 lb. Frozen; and 28,338,142 lb. Cured. With an addition of 4,380,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 47,874,827 lb. which was an increase of 424 thousand lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 14.0 million lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 4,505,631 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 4,925,631 lb. when 420,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 4.9 million lb. less than last year. The movement for December 1944 was "Into-Storage", being 450 thousand lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 8.5 million lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 29,343,593 lb. being classified as follows: 9,538,313 lb. Fresh; 14,696,681 lb. Frozen; 660,298 lb. Cured and 4,448,301 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 1,715,000 lb. the Grand Total was 31,058,593 lb. These stocks were 7.6 million lb. less than last year. The net "Into-Storage" movement was 512 thousand lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 8.3 million lb.

VEAL

The total holdings of Canadian veal amounted to 5,051,367 lb. including an estimate of 115,000 lb. for late firms. The reported holdings were 4,936,367 lb., being Fresh 539,126 lb.; Frozen 4,273,255 lb.; and Fancy Meats 123,986 lb. These stocks were 1.4 million lb. less than last month and 612 thousand lb. more than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The total holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb were 6,195,748 lb., consisting of Fresh 310,397 lb; Frozen 5,605,130 lb. and Fancy Meats 130,221 lb. These figures show an increase of 87 thousand lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.1 million lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on January 1 were 3,753,467 lb. as compared with 4,585,182 lb. on December 1.
