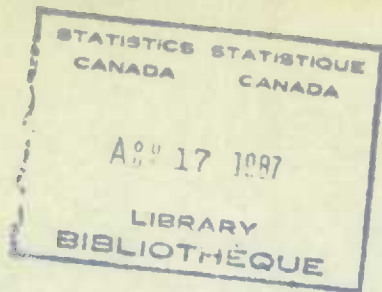

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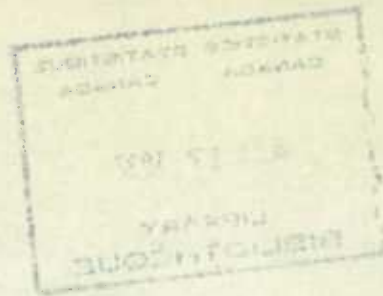
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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, OCTOBER 1, 1945

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 70,661,129 lb. Of this total there were 66,181,129 lb. of reported stocks and 4,480,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 70,882,500 lb. and last month 51,635,640 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Into-Storage" movement of 19.0 million lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 318 thousand lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 23,177,214 lb. being 4,088,133 lb. Fresh; 4,059,082 lb. Frozen and 15,029,999 lb. Cured. With an addition of 1,800,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 24,977,214 lb., which was an increase of 699 thousand lb. over last month. Last year there was an opposite movement of 4.1 million lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 773,973 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 833,973 lb. when 60,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 6.4 million lb. less than last year. The movement for September 1945 was "Out-of-Storage", being 101 thousand lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 6.9 million lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 32,183,889 lb. being classified as follows: 13,101,659 lb. Fresh; 16,175,562 lb. Frozen; 687,715 lb. Cured and 2,318,953 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 2,300,000 lb., the Grand Total was 34,483,889 lb. These stocks were 9.7 million lb. less than last year. The net "Into-Storage" movement was 15.1 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 3.4 million lb.

VEAL

The reported holdings were 6,652,385 lb., being Fresh; 1,966,846 lb. Frozen 4,479,438 lb.; and Fancy Meats 206,101 lb. These stocks were 1.0 million lb. more than last month and 119 thousand lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings were 4,167,641 lb., consisting of Fresh 996,622 lb., Frozen 2,922,476 lb., and Fancy Meats 248,543 lb. These figures show an increase of 2.2 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 943 thousand lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on October 1, were 1,612,901 lb. which was a decrease of 387 thousand lb. from last month and of 3.1 million lb. from last year.
