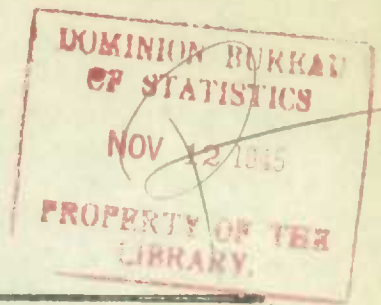

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD NOVEMBER 1, 1945

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 76,725,168 lb. Of this total there were 72,225,168 lb. of reported stocks and 4,500,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 79,710,341 lb. and last month 69,738,326 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Into-Storage" movement of 7.0 million lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 9.0 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 26,239,158 lb. being 5,116,661 lb. Fresh; 3,926,355 lb. Frozen and 17,196,142 lb. Cured. With an addition of 1,755,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 27,994,158 lb. which was an increase of 3.0 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 6.5 million lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 709,163 lb. These stocks were 3.9 million lb. less than last year. The movement for October 1945 was "Out-of-Storage", being 96 thousand lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 2.7 million lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 33,726,102 lb. being classified as follows: 11,027,157 lb. Fresh; 19,308,952 lb. Frozen; 624,816 lb. Cured and 2,765,177 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 2,060,000 lb., the Grand Total was 35,786,102 lb. These stocks were 10.6 million lb. more than last year. The net "Into-Storage" movement was 2.2 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 364 thousand lb.

VEAL

The reported holdings were 6,316,161 lb., being Fresh, 1,210,366 lb.; Frozen 4,954,939 lb.; and Fancy Meats 150,856 lb. with an addition of 425,000 lb. as an estimate for late firms the Grand Total was brought to 6,741,161 lb. These stocks were 104 thousand lb. less than last month and 243 thousand lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings were 5,943,747 lb., consisting of Fresh 1,038,123 lb., Frozen 4,705,668 lb., and Fancy Meats 199,956 lb. These figures show an increase of 1.9 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.8 million lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on November 1 including an estimate of 120,000 lb. for late firms were 1,701,220 lb. which was an increase of 16 thousand lb. over last month and a decrease of 2.8 million lb. from last year.
