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

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD DECEMBER 1, 1945

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT The Canadian meat stocks totalled 87,463,524 lb. Of this total there were 72,708,524 lb. of reported stocks and 14,755,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 90,851,302 lb. and last month 76,649,966 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Into-Storage" movement of 10.8 million lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 10.9 million lb.

PORK The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 25,056,318 lb. being 4,386,833 lb. Fresh; 4,671,766 lb. Frozen and 15,997,719 lb. Cured. With an addition of 5,140,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 30,196,318 lb. which was an increase of 2.3 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 4.4 million lb.

BEEF The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 35,108,281 lb. being classified as follows: 11,626,530 lb. Fresh; 19,564,490 lb. Frozen; 620,002 lb. Cured and 3,297,259 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 6,915,000 lb., the Grand Total was 42,023,281 lb. These stocks were 11.3 million lb. more than last year. The net "Into-Storage" movement was 6.1 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 5.5 million lb.

VEAL The reported holdings were 5,980,168 lb., being Fresh, 1,328,077 lb.; Frozen 4,498,190 lb.; and Fancy Meats 153,901 lb. With an addition of 1,700,000 lb. as an estimate for late firms the Grand Total was brought to 7,680,168 lb. These stocks were 797 thousand lb. less than last month and 1.2 million lb. more than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB The reported holdings were 6,563,757 lb., consisting of Fresh 597,170 lb., Frozen 5,734,762 lb., and Fancy Meats 231,825 lb. An estimate of 1 million lb. brought a grand total of 7,563,757 lb. These figures show an increase of 1.3 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.4 million lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW Stocks on December 1, including an estimate of 160,000 lb. for late firms, were 1,852,687 lb. which was an increase of 150 thousand lb. over last month and a decrease of 2.7 million lb. from last year.

LARD The quantity reported was 717,843 lb. These stocks were 3.8 million lb. less than last year.
