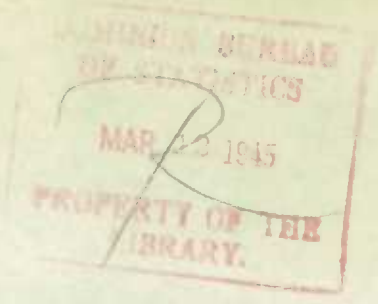

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, MARCH 1, 1945

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 85,276,497 lb. Of this total there were 82,406,497 lb. of reported stocks and 2,870,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 149,272,187 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out of Storage" movement of 10.6 million lb. while a year ago there was an opposite movement of 3.7 million lb.

There were no stocks of imported meat on March 1.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 46,524,024 lb.; being 5,525,205 lb. Fresh; 21,011,372 lb. Frozen; and 19,987,447 lb. Cured. With an addition of 1,960,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 48,484,024 lb. which was an increase of 379 thousand lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 5.2 million lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 3,470,921 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 3,645,921 lb. when 175,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 12.2 million lb. less than last year. The movement for February 1945 was "Out-of-Storage", being 629 thousand lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 6.0 million lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 29,419,373 lb. being classified as follows: 9,707,616 lb. Fresh; 13,912,634 lb. Frozen; 968,194 lb. Cured and 4,830,929 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 660,000 lb. the Grand Total was 30,079,373 lb. These stocks were 9.9 million lb. less than last year. The net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 5.1 million lb. Last year's figures showed an opposite movement of 1.3 million lb.

VEAL

The reported holdings were 2,379,585 lb., being Fresh 444,190 lb.; Frozen 1,831,375 lb.; and Fancy Meats 104,020 lb. These stocks were 1.3 million lb. less than last month and 598 thousand lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The total holdings of Canadian mutton and lamb were 4,333,515 lb. including an estimate of 250,000 lb. for late firms. The reported holdings were 4,083,515 lb. consisting of Fresh 179,672 lb.; Frozen 3,802,414 lb. and Fancy Meats 101,429 lb. These figures show a decrease of 1.7 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.3 million lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on March 1 were 4,247,441 lb. as compared with 4,611,089 lb. on February 1.

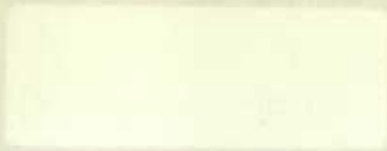
