COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD. MAY 1, 1945

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 91,115,758 lb. Of
this total there were 89,420,758 lb. of reported stocks
and 1,695,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 141,507,116
lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out of Storage" movement of 4.4 million lb.
while a year ago there was a similar movement of 7.7 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were
62,179,028 lb.; being 5,173,449 lb. Fresh; 34,997,230 lb.
Frozen; and 22,008,349 lb. Cured. With an addition of 1,360,000 lb. as an estimate
for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was
brought to 63,539,028 lb. which was an increase of 3.6 million lb. over last month.
Last year there was an opposite movement of 4 l million lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 2,592,943 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 2,777,943 lb. when 185,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 18.6 million lb. less than last year. The movement for April 1945 was "Out-of Storage", being 314 thousand lb. Last year there was an opposite movement of 1.4 million lb.

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 20,983,594 lb. being classified as follows: 6,686,710 lb. Fresh; 9,530,985 lb. Frozen; 1,222,304 lb. Cured and 3,543,595 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 335,000 lb. the Grand Total was 21,318,594 lb. These stocks were 9.8 million lb. less than last year. The net "Cut-of Storage" movement was 8.4 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 4.2 million lb.

VEAL

The reported holdings were 4,339,617 lb., being Fresh 1,045,550 lb.; Frozen 3,150,209 lb.; and Fancy Meats 143,858 lb. These stocks were 1.7 million lb. more than last month and 234 thousand lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings were 1,918,519 lb. consisting of Fresh 104,489 lb.; Frozen 1,673,769 lb. and Fancy Meats 140,261 lb. These figures show a decrease of 1.3 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.4 million lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW Stocks reported on May 1, were 3,857,785 lb. which was a decrease of 744 thousand lb. from last month and 2.9 million lb. from last year.
