#### COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, JUNE 1, 1945

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The canadian meat stocks totalled 77,430,267 lb. Of this total there were 70,335,267 lb. of reported stocks and 7,095,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 123,541,234 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 14.8 million lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 18.0 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 50,427,357 lb.; being 4,255,237 lb. Fresh; 22,612,527 lb. Frozen; and 23,559,593 lb. Cured. With an addition of 5,715,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 56,142,357 lb.. which was a decrease of 8.0 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 11.4 million lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 2,338,052 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 2,588,052 lb. when 250,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 18.8 million lb. less than last year. The movement for May 1945 was "Out-of-Storage", being 229 thousand lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 53 thousand lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 14,335,289 lb.
being classified as follows: 4,511,850 lb. Fresh; 6,910,795 lb.
Frozen; 473,975 lb. Cured and 2,438,669 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 1,300,000 lb. the Grand Total was 15,635,289 lb. These stocks were 9.6 million lb.
less than last year. The net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 6.0 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 5.9 million lb.

VEAL

The reported holdings were 4,693,274 lb., being Fresh 893,165 lb.; Frozen 3,658,018 lb.; and Fancy Meats 142,091 lb. These stocks were 390 thousand lb. more than last month and 893 thousand lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings were 879,347 lb., consisting of Fresh 61,923 lb.; Frozen 775,249 lb., and Fancy Meats 42,175 lb.

These figures show a decrease of 1.1 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.8 million lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW Stocks reported on June 1, were 3,519,159 lb. which was a decrease of 250 thousand lb. from last month and 3,3 million lb. from last year.
