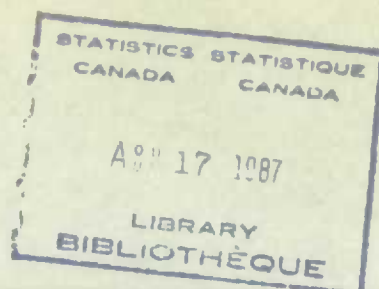

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, JULY 1, 1945

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 57,869,574 lb. Of this total there were 46,289,574 lb. of reported stocks and 11,580,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 105,645,352 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 20.2 million lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 17.9 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 30,379,797 lb.; being 3,231,665 lb. Fresh; 11,775,043 lb. Frozen; and 15,373,089 lb. Cured. With an addition of 8,700,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 39,079,797 lb. which was a decrease of 17.1 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 12.6 million lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 932,460 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 1,772,460 lb. when 840,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 19.7 million lb. less than last year. The movement for June 1945 was "Out-of-Storage", being 828 thousand lb. Last year there was an opposite movement of 92 thousand lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 10,674,957 lb. being classified as follows: 4,293,696 lb. Fresh; 4,203,980 lb. Frozen; 499,885 lb. Cured and 1,677,396 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 2,235,000 lb. The Grand Total was 12,909,957 lb. These stocks were 7.7 million lb. less than last year. The net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 3.2 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 4.6 million lb.

VEAL

The reported holdings were 4,667,209 lb., being Fresh 954,587 lb.; Frozen 3,580,562 lb.; and Fancy Meats 132,060 lb. These stocks were 211 thousand lb. more than last month and 870 thousand lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings were 567,611 lb., consisting of Fresh 185,327 lb., Frozen 346,740 lb., and Fancy Meats 35,544 lb. These figures show a decrease of 174 thousand lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 985 thousand lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks reported on July 1, were 1,812,729 lb. including an estimate of 850,000 lb. the total amounted to 2,662,729 lb. which was a decrease of 954 thousand lb. from last month and 3.7 million lb. from last year.

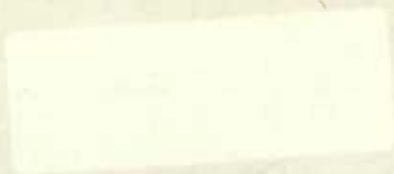
