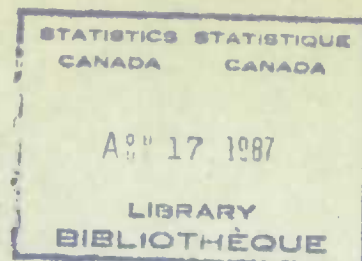

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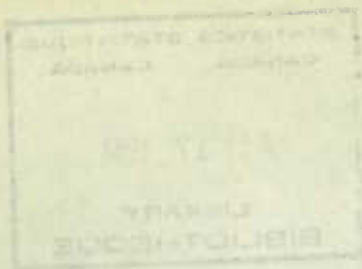
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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, AUGUST 1, 1945

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 48,595,459 lb. Of this total there were 43,150,459 lb. of reported stocks and 5,445,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 88,989,186 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 9.0 million lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 16.7 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 24,274,043 lb.; being 2,942,741 lb. Fresh; 7,173,582 lb. Frozen; and 14,157,720 lb. Cured. With an addition of 3,885,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 28,159,043 lb., which was a decrease of 10.3 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 16.1 million lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 1,637,695 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 1,717,695 lb. when 80,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 16.0 million lb. less than last year. The movement for July 1945 was "Out-of-Storage", being 105 thousand lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 3.7 million lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 12,597,176 lb. being classified as follows: 5,372,721 lb. Fresh; 5,233,967 lb. Frozen; 414,498 lb. Cured and 1,575,990 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 1,300,000 lb., the Grand Total was 13,897,176 lb. These stocks were 6.4 million lb. less than last year. The net "Into-Storage" movement was 740 thousand lb. Last year's figures showed an opposite movement of 223 thousand lb.

VEAL

The reported holdings were 5,221,010 lb., being Fresh 980,409 lb.; Frozen 4,035,984 lb.; and Fancy Meats 204,617 lb. These stocks were 307 thousand lb. less than last month and 910 thousand lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings were 1,058,230 lb., consisting of Fresh 220,468 lb., Frozen 717,877 lb., and Fancy Meats 119,885 lb. These figures show an increase of 225 thousand lb. over last month. Last year there was an opposite movement of 747 thousand lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks reported on August 1, were 1,510,364 lb. Including an estimate of 630,000 lb., the total amounted to 2,140,000 lb. which was a decrease of 577 thousand lb. from last month and 3.8 million lb. from last year.
