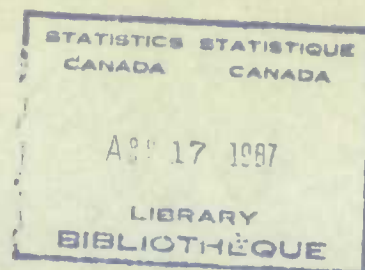

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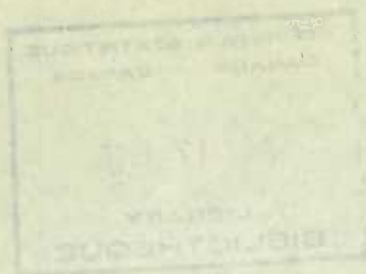
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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, SEPTEMBER 1, 1945

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 50,670,392 lb. Of this total there were 46,480,392 lb. of reported stocks and 4,190,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 70,564,838 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Into-Storage" movement of 1.7 million lb. while a year ago there was an opposite movement of 18.4 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 21,861,467 lb. being 3,719,789 lb. Fresh; 4,597,513 lb. Frozen; and 13,544,165 lb. Cured. With an addition of 1,830,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late for not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 23,691,467 lb., which was a decrease of 4.5 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 19.5 million lb.

LARD

The quantity reported was 872,975 lb. The Grand Total amounted to 957,975 lb. when 85,000 lb. were added as an estimate for firms failing to report on time. These stocks were 13.2 million lb. less than last year. The movement for August 1945 was "Out-of-Storage", being 782 thousand lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 3.6 million lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 16,857,236 lb. being classified as follows: 7,430,865 lb. Fresh; 7,355,692 lb. Frozen; 489,543 lb. Cured and 1,581,136 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 2,220,000 lb., the Grand Total was 19,077,233 lb. These stocks were 2.4 million lb. less than last year. The net "Into-Storage" movement was 5.1 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 1.1 million lb.

VEAL

The reported holdings were 5,570,226 lb., being Fresh 1,114,563 lb.; Frozen 4,275,348 lb.; and Fancy Meats 180,315 lb. These stocks were 71 thousand lb. less than last month and 921 thousand lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings were 2,191,453 lb., consisting of Fresh 717,590 lb., Frozen 1,289,015 lb., and Fancy Meats 184,848 lb. These figures show an increase of 1.2 million lb. over last month. Last year there was an opposite movement of 155 thousand lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks reported on September 1, were 1,911,993 lb. Including an estimate of 70,000 lb., the total amounted to 1,981,993 lb. which was an increase of 326 thousand lb. from last month and a decrease of 3.5 million lb. from last year.
