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#### COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD JANUARY 1, 1946

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 84,925,842 lb. Of this total there were 75,415,842 lb. of reported stocks and 9,510,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 92,769,111 lb. and last month 87,504,815 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 2.1 million lb. while a year ago there was an opposite movement of 1.9 million lb.

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 28,796,779 lb.
being 3,999,141 lb. Fresh; 9,869,813 lb. Frozen and 14,927,825
lb. Cured. With an addition of 3,980,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 32,776,779 lb. which was an increase of 2.3 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.4 million lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 34,564,944 lb.

being classified as follows: 7,376,614 lb. Fresh; 22,963,630 lb.

Frozen; 658,761 lb. Cured and 3,565,939 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 4,590,000 lb., the Grand Total was 39,154,944 lb. These stocks were 7.3 million lb.

more than last year. The "Out-of-Storage" movement was 3.0 million lb. Last year's figures showed an opposite movement of 1.1 million lb.

The reported holdings were 4,924,939 lb., being Fresh, 547,423 lb.; Frozen 4,285,549 lb.; and Fancy Meats 91,967 lb. With an addition of 250,000 lb. as an estimate for late firms the Grand Total was brought to 5,174,939 lb. These stocks were 2.0 million lb. less than last month and 20 thousand lb. more than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings were 7,129,180 lb., consisting of Fresh
495,252 lb., Frozen 6,167,715 lb., and Fancy Meats 466,213 lb.

An estimate of 690,000 lb. brought a grand total of 7,819,180 lb. These figures show
an increase of 66 thousand lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement
of 803 thousand lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW Stocks on January 1, including an estimate of 100,000 lb. for late firms, were 1,408,681 lb. which was a decrease of 514 thousand lb. from last month and of 2.7 million lb. from last year.

LARD The quantity reported was 843,610 lb. These stocks were 4.1 million lb. less than last year.
