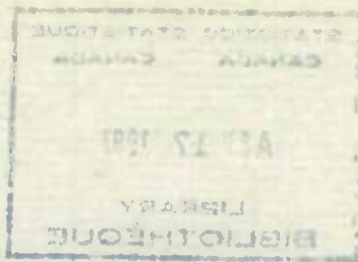

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD OCTOBER 1, 1946

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 51,244,038 lb. Of this total there were 44,699,038 lb. of reported stocks and 6,545,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 70,112,480 lb. and last month 52,352,985 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 1.1 million lb. while a year ago there was an opposite movement of 18.1 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 16,061,907 lb. being 2,811,617 lb. Fresh; 2,707,691 lb. Frozen and 10,542,599 lb. Cured. With an addition of 2,050,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 18,111,907 lb. which was a decrease of 7.8 million lb. from last month. Last year there was an opposite movement of 499 thousand lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 21,568,966 lb. being classified as follows: 9,240,611 lb. Fresh; 9,328,525 lb. Frozen; 946,316 lb. Cured and 2,053,514 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 4,070,000 lb., the Grand Total was 25,638,966 lb. These stocks were 8.2 million lb. less than last year. The "Into-Storage" movement was 6.7 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 14.4 million lb.

VEAL

The total holdings including an estimate of 80,000 lb. were 3,919,530 lb., being Fresh 747,319 lb., Frozen 2,927,467 lb., and Fancy Meats 164,744 lb. These stocks were 219 thousand lb. less than last month and 2.9 million lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The total holdings including an estimate of 345,000 lb. were 3,573,635 lb., consisting of Fresh 621,883 lb., Frozen 2,435,727 lb. and Fancy Meats 171,025 lb.. These figures show an increase of 120 thousand lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 2.0 million lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on October 1, were 1,262,898 lb. which was a decrease of 123 thousand lb. from last month and 422 thousand lb. from last year.

LARD

The total stocks were 533,100 lb. These stocks were 156 thousand lb. less than last month and 274 thousand lb. less than last year.

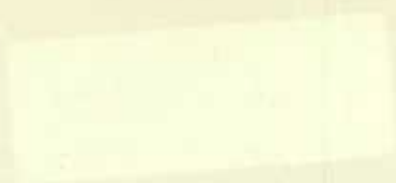
