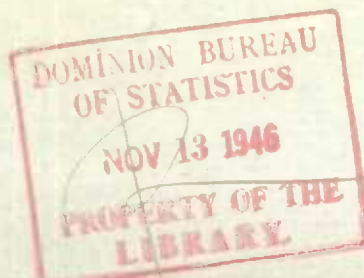

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD NOVEMBER 1, 1946

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 66,059,322 lb. Of this total there were 57,499,322 lb. of reported stocks and 8,560,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 77,192,917 lb. and last month 50,482,395 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Into-Storage" movement of 15.6 million lb. A year ago there was a similar movement of 7.1 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 22,208,635 lb. being 4,019,278 lb. Fresh; 3,231,382 lb. Frozen and 14,957,975 lb. Cured. With an addition of 3,690,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 25,898,635 lb. which was an increase of 7.8 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 3.0 million lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 25,312,689 lb. being classified as follows: 10,139,666 lb. Fresh; 11,948,305 lb. Frozen; 1,058,191 lb. Cured and 2,166,527 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 3,900,000 lb., the Grand Total was 29,212,689 lb. These stocks were 6.7 million lb. less than last year. The "Into-Storage" movement was 4.5 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 2.0 million lb.

VEAL

The total holdings including an estimate of 280,000 lb. were 4,388,010 lb., being Fresh 1,067,791 lb., Frozen 2,852,071 lb., and Fancy Meats 188,148 lb. These stocks were 367 thousand lb. more than last month and 2.5 million lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The total holdings including an estimate of 690,000 lb. were 6,559,988 lb., consisting of Fresh 1,081,776 lb., Frozen 4,553,156 lb. and Fancy Meats 235,056 lb.. These figures show an increase of 2.9 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 2.0 million lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on November 1, were 1,499,913 lb. which was an increase of 106 thousand lb. over last month and a decrease of 203 thousand lb. from last year.

LARD

The total stocks were 874,237 lb. These stocks were 286 thousand lb. more than last month and 100 thousand lb. more than last year.
