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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD DECEMBER 1, 1946

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 81,876,210 lb. Of this total there were 76,386,210 lb. of reported stocks and 5,490,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 87,521,324 lb. and last month 66,361,071 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Into-Storage" movement of 15.5 million lb. A year ago there was a similar movement of 10.3 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 31,265,599 lb. being 5,232,529 lb. Fresh, 11,754,530 lb. Frozen and 14,278,540 lb. Cured. With an addition of 2,405,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 33,670,599 lb. which was an increase of 7.3 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 2.2 million lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 33,353,327 lb. being classified as follows: 11,254,608 lb. Fresh, 17,883,887 lb. Frozen, 1,161,054 lb. Cured and 3,053,778 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 2,435,000 lb., the Grand Total was 35,788,327 lb. These stocks were 6.5 million lb. less than last year. The "Into-Storage" movement was 7.0 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 6.3 million lb.

VEAL

The total holdings, including an estimate of 95,000 lb., were 4,787,603 lb., being Fresh 944,855 lb., Frozen 3,544,386 lb., and Fancy Meats 203,362 lb. These stocks were 234 thousand lb. more than last month and 2.4 million lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The total holdings, including an estimate of 555,000 lb., were 7,629,681 lb., consisting of Fresh 506,762 lb., Frozen 6,334,411 lb. and Fancy Meats 233,508 lb. These figures show an increase of 988 thousand lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.5 million lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on December 1, were 2,196,880 lb., which was an increase of 634 thousand lb. over last month and of 274 thousand lb. over last year.

LARD

The total stocks were 943,824 lb. These stocks were 34 thousand lb. less than last month and 130 thousand lb. more than last year.
