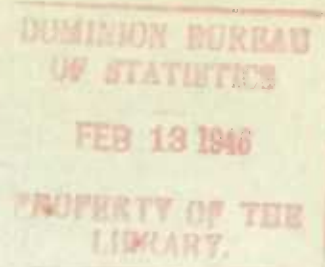

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD FEBRUARY 1, 1946

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 73,447,327 lb. Of this total there were 70,957,327 lb. of reported stocks and 2,490,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 94,394,080 lb. and last month 86,326,850 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 12.9 million lb. while a year ago there was an opposite movement of 1.6 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 34,291,300 lb. being 3,257,641 lb. Fresh; 17,215,551 lb. Frozen and 13,818,108 lb. Cured. With an addition of 1,130,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 35,421,300 lb. which was an increase of 2.7 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 781 thousand lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 28,439,335 lb. being classified as follows: 7,162,563 lb. Fresh; 17,397,740 lb. Frozen; 613,624 lb. Cured and 3,265,408 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 920,000 lb., the Grand Total was 29,359,335 lb. These stocks were 5.8 million lb. less than last year. The "Out-of-Storage" movement was 11.2 million lb. Last year's figures showed an opposite movement of 3.3 million lb.

VEAL

The reported holdings were 2,883,293 lb., being Fresh 284,514 lb.; Frozen 2,514,449 lb.; and Fancy Meats 84,330 lb. With an addition of 140,000 lb. as an estimate for late firms the Grand Total was brought to 3,023,293 lb. These stocks were 2.3 million lb. less than last month and 588 thousand lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings were 5,343,399 lb., consisting of Fresh 289,604 lb., Frozen 4,941,470 lb., and Fancy Meats 112,325 lb. An estimate of 300,000 lb. brought a grand total of 5,643,399 lb. These figures show a decrease of 2.1 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 934 thousand lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on February 1, including an estimate of 75,000 lb. for late firms, were 1,258,714 lb. which was a decrease of 231 thousand lb. from last month and of 3.3 million lb. from last year.

LARD

The quantity reported was 813,615 lb. With an estimate of 70,000 the Grand Total was brought to 883,615 lb. These stocks were 3.5 million lb. less than last year and 71 thousand lb. less than last month.
