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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, MARCH 1, 1946

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT The Canadian meat stocks totalled 70,198,368 lb. Of this total there were 64,023,368 lb. of reported stocks and 6,175,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 88,317,260 lb. and last month 76,323,572 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 6.1 million lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 6.1 million lb.

PORK The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 36,860,747 lb. being 3,820,371 lb. Fresh; 18,964,860 lb. Frozen and 14,075,516 lb. Cured. With an addition of 3,925,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 40,785,747 lb. which was an increase of 4.0 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 2.0 million lb. There were also 102,112 lb. of imported stocks.

BEEF The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 21,689,180 lb. being classified as follows: 6,287,208 lb. Fresh; 12,357,597 lb. Frozen; 769,109 lb. Cured and 2,275,266 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 2,170,000 lb., the Grand Total was 23,859,180 lb. These stocks were 5.9 million lb. less than last year. The "Out-of-Storage" movement was 6.8 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 5.3 million lb.

VEAL The reported holdings were 1,738,480 lb., being Fresh 359,820 lb.; Frozen 1,294,531 lb.; and Fancy Meats 84,129 lb. These stocks were 1.4 million lb. less than last month and 755 thousand lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB The reported holdings were 3,734,961 lb., consisting of Fresh 238,879 lb., Frozen 3,428,070 lb., and Fancy Meats 78,012 lb. An estimate of 80,000 lb. brought a grand total of 3,814,961 lb. These figures show a decrease of 1.9 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.6 million lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW Stocks on March 1, including an estimate of 140,000 lb. for late firms, were 1,294,836 lb. which was an increase of 58 thousand lb. over last month and a decrease of 2.9 million lb. from last year.

LARD The quantity reported was 1,315,178 lb. With an estimate of 120,000 lb. the Grand Total was brought to 1,435,178 lb. These stocks were 2.3 million lb. less than last year and 538 thousand lb. more than last month.

There were also 116,446 lb. of imported lard.
