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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD APRIL 1, 1946

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 76,845,123 lb. Of this total there were 75,670,123 lb. of reported stocks and 1,175,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 98,886,280 lb. and last month 70,164,037 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Into-Storage" movement of 6.7 million lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 10.6 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 49,816,674 lb.
being 4,732,843 lb. Fresh; 27,878,395 lb. Frozen and 17,205,436
lb. Cured. With an addition of 665,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 50,481,674 lb. which was an increase of 9.8 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 11.7 million lb. There were also 13,826 lb. of Imported stocks.

BEEF
The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 20,496,219 lb.
being classified as follows: 6,734,616 lb. Fresh; 11,143,442
lb. Frozen; 681,031 lb. Cured and 1,937,130 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 480,000 lb., the Grand Total was 20,976,219 lb. These stocks were 8.7 million lb.
less than last year. The "Out-of-Storage" movement was 2.8 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 139 thousand lb.

VEAL

The reported holdings were 2,024,708 lb., being Fresh 830,203 lb.; Frozen 1,088,457 lb.; and Fancy Meats 106,048 lb. These stocks were 213 thousand lb. more than last month and 642 thousand lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings were 3,332,522 lb., consisting of Fresh 247,068 lb., Frozen 3,012,267 lb., and Fancy Meats 73,187 lb.

An estimate of 30,000 lb. brought a grand total of 3,362,522 lb. These figures show a decrease of 470 thousand lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.2 million lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on April, 1. Were 1,170,274 lb. which was a decrease of 133 thousand lb. from last month and 3.3 million lb. from last

year.

LARD

The quantity reported was 1,366,281 lb. These stocks were 140 thousand lb. less than last month and 1.8 million lb. less

than last year.

There were also 5,772 lb. of Imported lard.
