

#### COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD MAY 1. 1946

Held by Packers, Abatteirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cols Storage Warehouses

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 58,485,053 lb. Of this total there were 53,905,053 lb. of reported stocks and 4,580,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 92,354,665 lb. and last month 76,399,764 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 17.9 million lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 6.5 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 54,249,387 lb.

being 5,087,767 lb. Fresh; 34,068,911 lb. Frozen and 15,092,709

lb. Cured. With an addition of 3,280,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 57,529,387 lb. which was an increase of 7.6 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 953 thousand lb. There were also 16,610 lb. of Imported stocks.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 14,625,497 lb.

being classified as follows: 2,966,824 lb. Fresh; 9,692,070 lb.

Frozen; 600,806 lb. Cured and 1,365,797 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 1,050,000 lb., the Grand Total was 15,675,497 lb. These stocks were 6.0 million lb.

less than last year. The "Out-of-Storage" movement was 5.8 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 8.0 million lb.

VEAL
The reported holdings were 3,205,129 lb., being Fresh 891,450 lb.
Frozen 2,213,020 lb.; and Fancy Meats 100,659 lb. These stocks
were 1.4 million lb. more than last month and 976 thousand lb. less than last year's
holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings were 2,005,516 lbc, consisting of Fresh 127,561 lb., Frozen 1,826,930 lb. and Fancy Meats 51,025 lb.

These figures show a decrease of 1.3 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.3 million lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW Stocks on May 1, were 933,735 lb. which was a decrease of 237 thousand lb. from last month and 2.9 million lb. from last year.

LARD
The total stocks including an estimate of 100,000 lb. were 1,379,857 lb. These stocks were 27 thousand lb. less than last month and 1.5 million lb. less than last year.
