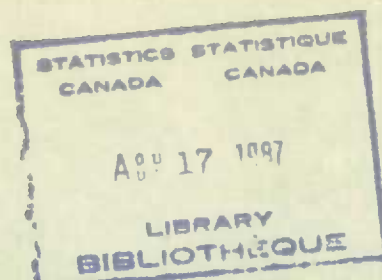

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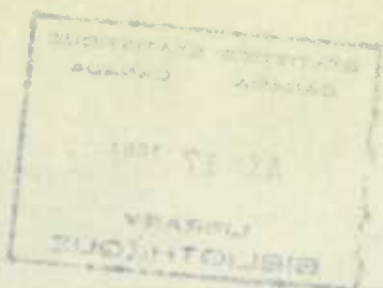
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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD JUNE 1, 1946

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 73,685,688 lb. Of this total there were 67,045,688 lb. of reported stocks and 6,640,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 79,537,401 lb. and last month 77,731,849 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 4.0 million lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 12.8 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 52,059,435 lb. being 3,930,713 lb. Fresh; 33,889,828 lb. Frozen and 14,238,894 lb. Cured. With an addition of 4,830,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 56,889,435 lb. which was a decrease of 698 thousand lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 6.6 million lb. There were also 1,965 lb. of Imported stocks.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 10,598,760 lb. being classified as follows: 3,262,122 lb. Fresh; 5,900,350 lb. Frozen; 362,646 lb. Cured and 1,073,642 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 1,725,000 lb., the Grand Total was 12,323,760 lb. These stocks were 3.7 million lb. less than last year. The "Out-of-Storage" movement was 2.4 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 5.6 million lb.

VEAL

The reported holdings were 3,355,541 lb., being Fresh 679,020 lb. Frozen 2,567,490 lb.; and Fancy Meats 109,031 lb. These stocks were 99 thousand lb. more than last month and 1.5 million lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings were 1,031,952 lb., consisting of Fresh 68,265 lb., Frozen 937,604 lb. and Fancy Meats 26,083 lb. These figures show a decrease of 1.0 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.0 million lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on June 1, were 864,755 lb. which was a decrease of 91 thousand lb. from last month and 2.8 million lb. from last year.

LARD

The total stocks including an estimate of 25,000 lb. were 1,216,027 lb. These stocks were 203 thousand lb. less than last month and 1.4 million lb. less than last year.
