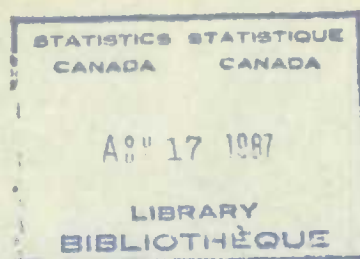

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD AUGUST 1, 1946

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 56,964,425 lb. Of this total there were 51,054,425 lb. of reported stocks and 5,910,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 49,935,189 lb. and last month 73,464,104 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of ~~18.5~~ 14.3 million lb. while a year ago there was a similar movement of 8.0 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 35,215,097 lb. being 2,798,658 lb. Fresh; 18,981,803 lb. Frozen and 13,434,636 lb. Cured. With an addition of 4,275,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 39,490,097 lb. which was a decrease of ~~14.0~~ 11.9 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 9.7 million lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 11,120,321 lb. being classified as follows: 5,191,293 lb. Fresh; 4,110,439 lb. Frozen; 523,765 lb. Cured and 1,294,824 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 1,360,000 lb., the Grand Total was 12,480,321 lb. These stocks were 1.7 million lb. less than last year. The "Out-of-Storage" movement was 3.1 million lb. Last year's figures showed an opposite movement of 905 thousand lb.

VEAL

The reported holdings were 3,583,131 lb., being Fresh 796,775 lb. Frozen 2,676,269 lb. and Fancy Meats 110,087 lb. These stocks were 293 thousand lb. more than last month and 1.9 million lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The total holdings were 1,195,876 lb., consisting of Fresh 396,656 lb., Frozen 690,147 lb. and Fancy Meats 49,073 lb. These figures show an increase of 365 thousand lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 327 thousand lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on August 1, were 1,145,072 lb. which was a decrease of 105 thousand lb. from last month and 515 thousand lb. from last year.

LARD

The total stocks were 758,405 lb. These stocks were 259 thousand lb. less than last month and 946 thousand lb. less than last year.

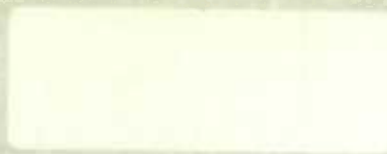
