COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD SEPTEMBER 1, 1946

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 51,343,477 lb. Of this total there were 48,278,477 lb. of reported stocks and 3,065,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 52,029,323 lb. and last month 57,496,424 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 6.2 million lb. while a year ago there was an opposite movement of 2.1 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 24,264,505 lb. being 2,887,998 lb. Fresh; 7,552,055 lb. Frozen and 13,824,452 lb. Cured. With an addition of 1,395,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 25,659,505 lb. which was a decrease of 14.2 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 4.4 million lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 16,686,538 lb. being classified as follows: 7,997,134 lb. Fresh; 6,226,014 lb. Frozen; 587,332 lb. Cured and 1,876,058 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 1,360,000 lb., the Grand Total was 18,046,538 lb. These stocks were 1.5 million lb. less than last year. The "Into-Storage" movement was 5.5 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 5.3 million lb.

VEAL

The reported holdings were 4,107,346 lb., being Fresh 935,861 lb. Frozen 3,035,965 lb. and Fancy Meats 135,520 lb. These stocks were 345 thousand lb. more than last month and 1.6 million lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The total holdings were 3,495,088 lb., consisting of Fresh 745,889 lb., Frozen 2,261,501 lb. and Fancy Meats 212,698 lb. These figures show an increase of 2.2 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.1 million lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on September 1, were 1,408,643 lb. which was an increase of 260 thousand lb. over last month and a decrease of 591 thousand lb. from last year.

LARD

The total stocks were 659,970 lb. These stocks were 172 thousand lb. less than last month and 281 thousand lb. less than last year.
