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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD JANUARY 1, 1947

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 79,242,709 lb. Of this total there were 68,657,709 lb. of reported stocks and 10,585,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 87,040,865 lb. and last month 82,313,107 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 3.1 million lb. A year ago there was a similar movement of 480 thousand lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 34,219,326 lb. being 2,992,062 lb. Fresh, 19,023,098 lb. Frozen and 12,204,166 lb. Cured. With an addition of 5,045,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 39,264,326 lb. which was an increase of 5.7 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 2.8 million lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 24,910,454 lb. being classified as follows: 4,698,028 lb. Fresh, 16,661,807 lb. Frozen, 1,097,984 lb. Cured and 2,452,635 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 4,830,000 lb., the Grand Total was 29,740,454 lb. These stocks were 11 million lb. less than last year. The "Out-of-Storage" movement was 6.3 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 1.4 million lb.

MUTTON & LAMB

The total holdings, including an estimate of 525,000 lb., were 6,863,430 lb., consisting of Fresh 206,738 lb., Frozen 5,933,421 lb. and Fancy Meats 198,271 lb. These figures show a decrease of 856 thousand lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 37 thousand lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on January 1, were 1,499,128 lb., which was a decrease of 774 thousand lb. from last month and an increase of 9 thousand lb. over last year.

LARD

The total stocks were 1,374,026 lb. These stocks were 184 thousand lb. more than last month and 402 thousand lb. more than last year.

VEAL

The total holdings, including an estimate of 185,000 lb., were 3,374,499 lb., being Fresh 399,354 lb., Frozen 2,661,456 lb., and Fancy Meats 128,689 lb. These stocks were 1.6 million lb. less than last month and 2.0 million lb. less than last year's holdings.
