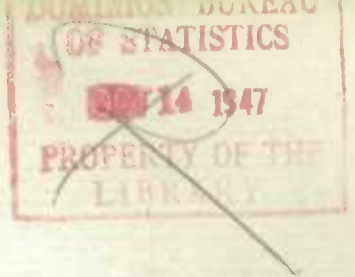

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD

OCTOBER 1, 1947

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 49,054,320 lb. Of this total there were 42,344,320 lb. of reported stocks and 6,710,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 51,023,295 lb. and last month 62,069,891 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "out-of-storage" movement of 13.0 million lb. A year ago there was a similar movement of 1.4 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 26,333,430 lb. being 2,655,224 lb. Fresh, 10,761,493 lb. Frozen and 12,916,713 lb. Cured. With an addition of 3,990,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 30,323,430 lb. which was a decrease of 4.5 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 7.5 million lb. There were 178,138 lb. imported pork stocks.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 9,901,294 lb. being classified as follows: 1,759,056 lb. Fresh, 5,690,056 lb. Frozen 841,681 lb. Cured and 1,610,501 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 2,100,000 lb. the Grand Total was 12,001,294 lb. These stocks were 12.8 million lb. less than last year. The "out-of-storage" movement was 7.3 million lb. Last year's figures showed an opposite movement of 6.0 million lb. Stocks of imported beef amounted to 176.278 lb.

VEAL

The total holdings, including an estimate of 520,000 lb. were 4,783,335 lb. being Fresh 272,511 lb. Frozen 3,909,908 lb. and Fancy Meats 80,916 lb. These stocks were 899 thousand lb. less than last month and 748 thousand lb. more than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings, were 1,846,261 lb. being classified as follows: Fresh 125,038 lb. Frozen 1,618,919 lb. and Fancy Meats 102,304 lb. Including an estimate of 100,000 lb. the Grand Total was 1,946,261 lb. These figures show a decrease of 349 thousand lb. from last month. Last year there was an opposite movement of 233 thousand lb.

LARD

The total stocks, including an estimate of 180,000 lb. were 1,376,108 lb. These stocks were 1.2 million lb. less than last month and 781 thousand lb. more than last year.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on October 1 were 1,627,987 lb. which was a decrease of 283 thousand lb. from last month.
