#### COLD STORAGE HULDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD NOVEMBER 1, 1947

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Dutchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT The Canadian meat stocks totalled 62,479,576 lb. Of this total there were 53,479,576 lb. of reported stocks and 9,000,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 66,993,276 lb. and last month 49,839,260 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "into-storage" movement of 12.6 million lb. A year ago there was a similar movement of 16.0 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 32,757,521 lb. being 7,871,283 lb. Fresh 11,337,598 lb. Frozen and 13,548,640 lb. Cured. With an addition of 5,190,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought up to 37,957,521 lb. which was an increase of 6.9 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 8.2 million lb. There were 47,192 lb. imported pork stocks.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 13,610,263 lb. being classified as follows: 6,291,386 lb. Fresh, 4,668,222 lb. Frozen 504,988 lb. Cured and 2,145,667 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 2,860,000 lb. the Grand Total was 16,470,263 lb. These stocks were 12.6 million lb. less than last year. The "intostorage" movement was 4.5 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 4.2 million lb.

VEAL

The total holdings, including an estimate of 560,000 lb. were 5,379,431 lb. being Fresh 1,080,796 lb. Frozen 3,598,470 lb. and Fancy Meats 140,165 lb. These stocks were 576 thousand lb. more than last month and 720, thousand lb. more than last year's holdings.

#### MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings, were 2,292,361 lb. being classified as follows: Fresh 458,450 lb. Frozen 1,711,416 lb. and Fancy Meats 122,495 lb. Including an estimate of 390,000 lb. the Grand Total was 2,682,361 lb. These figures show an increase of 657 thousand lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 3.0 million lb.

LARD

The total stocks, including an estimate of 100,000 lb. were 1,454,608 lb. These stocks were 71 thousand lb. more than last month and 477 thousand lb. more than last year.

#### EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on November 1 were 1,906,032 lb. which was an increase of 245 thousand lb. over last month.
